Children in St Wilfrid's Catholic Primary School in Birmingham brought in spare change to buy some **CHIRPY CHICKENS! £20**



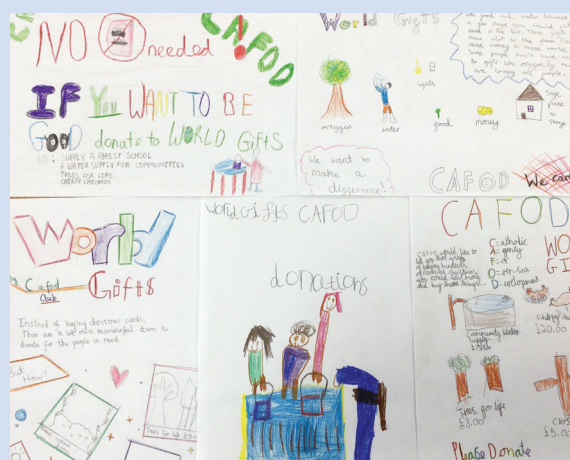
CHRISTMAS SALE
