Your handy checklist





Arrange to give the short talk (or ask a parishioner who reads regularly at Mass if they can give the talk) at Masses on **8/9 March** or **15/16 March** (or another date during Lent that suits your parish).



Put the Fast Day poster up on the noticeboard before **Ash Wednesday**.



Place a notice about the appeal in your parish newsletter.



Order pens for parishioners to fill out their envelopes from **shop.cafod.org.uk** You can order Lent prayer cards from the shop as well!



Hand out Fast Day envelopes to parishioners as they come into church and stand at the exit **to collect donations** and thank people at the end of Mass.



Wear your volunteer lanyard when you hold the parish collection – tell parishioners they can scan the QR Code to give online.



Order a CAFOD contactless device!
