


Paper bag kite instructions




What you will need:

- 1 paper bag
- Colouring pencils/ pens or paints, other decorating materials if desired
- Scissors
- String
- A strong paper straw or lolly stick
- Tape or glue
- Tissue paper (optional) to make streamers for the bottom of the kite


- 1.** Turn your bag upside down and decorate as creatively as possible. (You might be inspired by the story of the Ascension)




- 2.** Cut a small hole in the bottom of your bag. This will be the top of your kite.




- 3.** Tie one end of your string to the middle of the straw or lolly stick.



- 4.** Feed the other end through the hole in the bag. The straw/stick will keep the kite string from pulling out when it's flying.



- 5.** Cut tissue paper strips and attach to the open end of the bag using tape or glue.



- 6.** Now the kite is ready to fly!
