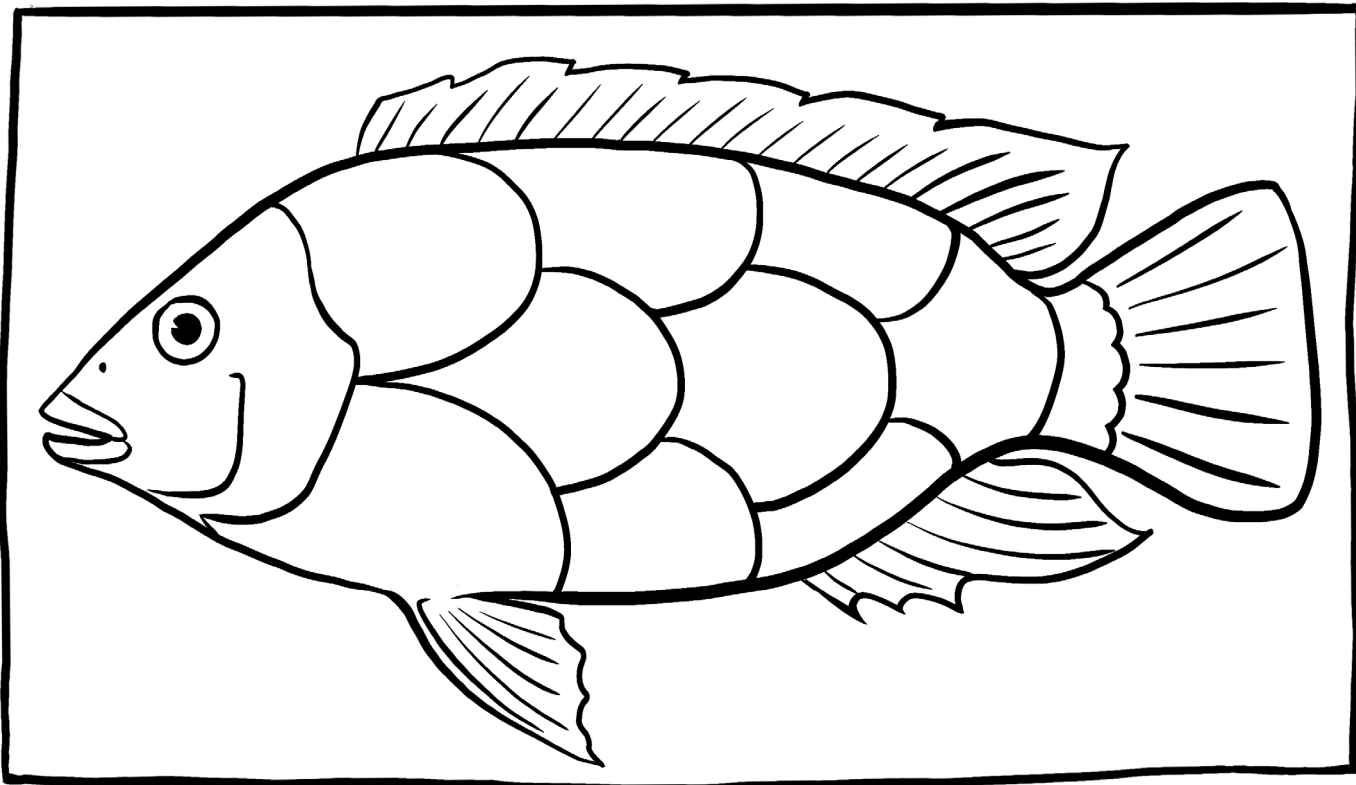


## Third Sunday of Easter

**“You are witnesses of these things”**



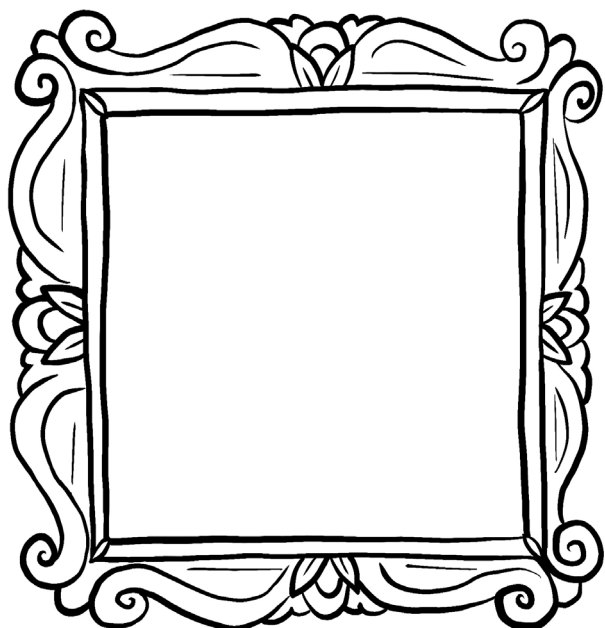
