





Northern Lights


Please be aware that a valid driver's license is needed to drive the ATVs. Likewise, the age limit for riding the ATV is 6 years old.

Whale Watching

Beaked dolphins, minke whales, humpback whales— these are the species commonly seen on this extraordinary tour. Departing from Reykjavík, you are brought face-to-face with the graceful power and stunning acrobatics of the mammoth creatures found in Iceland's coastal waters.

Helicopter - Reykjanes

Private / 1 hour | From ISK 300000 / 1-6 persons

Soaring across the Reykjanes Peninsula in a private helicopter, you will be greeted by visions of sprawling lava fields, geysers, mud pools, hot springs, endless craters, stunning lakes, extinct volcanoes, and an astounding aerial view of the Blue Lagoon. This airborne excursion can also be expanded to include other parts of Iceland.

Helicopter - Golden Circle

Private / 3 to 4 hour | From ISK 550200 / 1-6 persons

Experience the Golden Circle from above. Fly across Þingvellir National Park, the Geysir Geothermal Area, and Gullfoss waterfall as the volcanic earth's geological marvels reveal themselves against a spellbinding backdrop of enchanting terrain, thundering rivers, and sprawling lava fields. Liberated from the constraints of the roads below, you see the Golden Circle in a new light.




Lava Tunnel

1 hour | ISK 6900 per person 3 to 4 hours | ISK 19900 per person

Explore Raufarhólshellir, one of the longest and most astonishing lava tunnels in Iceland. A journey into Raufarhólshellir is a unique experience and a great opportunity to witness the inner workings of a volcanic event as one walks in the path of lava that flowed during the Leitahraun eruption, which occurred east of the Bláfjöll mountains about 5200 years ago. Every winter, spectacular ice sculptures form inside the cave's entrance, enhancing the breathtaking nature of this lava tunnel experience.



Experience the breathtaking realm of the interior of a volcano. Descend into the earth and discover an unforgettable suterranean wonderland as you explore the spellbinding geology of lava chambers created thousands of years ago by Iceland's tremendous eruptive powers.

Operated from May 10 – October 31. Transfer not included. Approximately 73 km from Silica.






Snowmobile


Zooming across the vastness of Langjökull glacier, you feel the full-blown adrenalin rush of gliding through a pristine snowscape, ascending to heights that reveal mesmerizing panoramas of Iceland's untamed, untouched wilderness.

A valid drivers license is required. Transfer not included. Tour departs from Gullfoss Café which is 161 km from Silica (approximately 2,5 hours by car).
