Requirements (International Students)

To apply for **Year 11**, students must:

- Have completed Year 10 or equivalent qualification
- Demonstrate English language proficiency equivalent to IELTS 5.5

We offer English for Secondary Schools (High School Preparation) studies, allowing students to enroll and strengthen their skills before starting Year 11.

To apply for **Year 12**, students must:

- Have completed Year 11
- Demonstrate English language proficiency equivalent to IELTS 5.5

Assessment Methods

Assessment in the VCE at Acknowledge Education is designed to support student learning, monitor achievement of curriculum outcomes, and prepare students for successful completion of the VCE.

Assessment methods are varied and aligned with both the **Victorian Curriculum** and **Assessment Authority (VCAA)** requirements, ensuring validity, fairness, and reliability. Students are assessed through a combination of formative and summative tasks, including class-based activities, practical demonstrations, projects, performance tasks, essays, research assignments, oral presentations, and examinations.
