

## **Pride Month Art Competition**

## **Terms and Conditions**

- 1. Eligibility: Open to all currently enrolled Acknowledge Education students.
- 2. Submission Limit: One entry per student.
- **3. Format:** Acceptable formats include digital art, photography, painting, posters, or mixed media. Must be submitted as an image or PDF.
- **4. Submission Method:** Upload your artwork to the designated Google Drive folder. Include your full name, student ID, and campus in the file name.
- **5. Originality:** All work must be original and created by the student. Collaborative work is not eligible.
- **6. Deadline:** All entries must be submitted by 25/06.
- **7. Content Guidelines:** Entries must be respectful and aligned with the theme of LGBTQ+ pride, identity, and/or allyship. Any discriminatory, offensive, or inappropriate content will be disqualified.
- **8. Permission:** By submitting, you grant Acknowledge Education permission to display and publish your work across its platforms (e.g., website, campus displays, social media, student handbook).
- **9. Winner Selection:** One winner will be chosen based on the judging criteria listed below. The decision of the judging panel is final and not subject to appeal.
- **10. Prize:** The winning artwork will be framed and displayed on campus, and the winner will receive a \$500 Gift Card.
- 11. Announcement: The winner will be announced during the final week of June 2025.

## **Judging Criteria**

- Relevance to Theme: How well the artwork reflects LGBTQ+ pride, identity, or allyship.
- Creativity: Originality of concept, design, and execution.
- Impact: Visual/emotional impact and ability to inspire or engage viewers.
- Presentation: Clarity, composition, and overall aesthetic quality.
