They're led by Johnnie Walker's Master Blender Emma Walker, who can call upon our unrivalled stocks of 10 million casks of Single Grain and Single Malt Scotch Whiskies. She knows the character of each one – from the ingredients used, to the treatment of the casks – and also how they react when combined. But creating an exceptional blend is more than just a comprehensive knowledge. It's an art form.

When making a Single Malt Whisky, the goal is to create something typical of that single distillery's style. Comparing the two different kinds doesn't really make sense – they're not meant to be the same. It's down to whichever flavours and style you prefer. DISTILLERIES A - Z

AUCHROISK

Phonetic Pronunciation: Orth-rusk

Location: Speyside

Flavour + Characteristics: Toffee / Fresh Apricot / Cut Grass

Brief History:

Auchroisk marked the start of a new era for blended scotch in 1972 as a modernist structure in the moorland. The first single malt bottling of Auchroisk was the first to carry the prefix of "Singleton" which is now used by other distilleries.

Auchroisk is one of the first examples of "finishing" with the ten-year-old single malt being decanted into ex-sherry casks for a further two years.

BENRINNES

Phonetic Pronunciation: Ben-rin-es

Location: Speyside

Flavour + Characteristics: Meaty / Biscuit / Prunes

Brief History:

Hugely demanded by blenders due to its meaty complexion and soft undertones. Benrinnes is always a hit with sherry lovers with its dry, nutty but full-bodied nature.

An intriguing distillery on the lower slopes of the sentinel mountain, the complex distillation process using six stills and a worm tub has been simplified over the last century, whilst retaining its unique character.

BLAIR ATHOL

Phonetic Pronunciation: Bler-ath-ol

Location: Highlands

Flavour + Characteristics: Malt Loaf / Walnuts / Satay Spice

Brief History:

One of the oldest legal whisky making sites in Scotland, located near the picturesque tourist hotspot of Pitlochry. Most of the liquid at Blair Athol is aged in ex-bourbon barrels, primed for blending.

The few single malt bottlings available however, are mostly aged in ex-sherry casks. With a short fermentation, cloudy worts with the body coming from distillation.

BRORA

Phonetic Pronunciation: Bror-ra

Location: Highlands

Flavour + Characteristics: Ground Almond / BBQ Pineapple / Leather

Brief History:

Only recently re-opened since its closure in 1983, this cult distillery, the original Clynelish, has undergone various levels of production and ownership since inception. Thus, the whisky produced over time has been hugely diverse but still all contain the unique tropical-maritime notes with different levels of peat smoke.

CAMERONBRIDGE

Phonetic Pronunciation: Cam-ron-bridge

Location: Lowlands

Flavour + Characteristics: Spiced Cereal / Papaya / Oak Shavings

Brief History:

Formerly known as Cameron-Brig, this is the largest grain distillery in Europe, providing whisky for many blends. This often-overlooked distillery has a rich history when it comes to grain whisky, intertwining with the Haig brand.

Expansion since 2007 has meant that Cameronbridge is integral to not only Johnnie Walker but also being home to one of the worlds iconic gin brands, Tanqueray.

CAOL ILA

Phonetic Pronunciation: Cull-eela

Location: Islands

Flavour + Characteristics: Fresh Pear / Bonfire Smoke / Green Juniper

Brief History:

Although Caol Ila receives the same spec of malt as sister distillery Lagavulin, Caol Ila's distillation regime which has longer fermentation, higher cut point and taller stills all attributes to its unique properties.

The Gaelic translation of Caol Ila is "Sound of Islay". It is no wonder why this distillery has a cult following, making Caol Ila one of Scotland's most visited distilleries.

Phonetic Pronunciation: Car-doo

Location: Speyside

Flavour + Characteristics: Fruit Cake / Pear Drops / Oaked Honey

Brief History:

One of the "homes" of Johnnie Walker. This distillery is steeped in blending history. Most notably as one of the key malts originally used in the Johnnie Walker blends for its consistency and quality.

The story of Helen and Elizabeth Cumming, however, is the highlight for many visitors. Two determined women who kept the distillery operational with verve and ingenuity.

CLYNELISH

Phonetic Pronunciation: Kline-leash

Location: Highlands

Flavour + Characteristics: Tropical Fruit / Wax / Scotch Bonnet Chilli

Brief History:

The highland home of Johnnie Walker in the coastal area of Sutherland. The unique landscape shapes the profile of the whisky. Interestingly, the distillery building is an exact replica of Caol Ila, whilst the name Clynelish was the original name for Brora.

The name Clynelish is an anglicised version of the Gaelic meaning green pastures.

CONVALMORE

Phonetic Pronunciation: Con-vul-moor

Location: Speyside

Flavour + Characteristics: Honey / Fruit Pastries / Orange Candy

Brief History:

Convalmore was founded in June of 1893 by the Convalmore-Glenlivet Distillery Company. In March of 1904, it was purchased by blender and whisky merchant W & P Lowrie & Co, who used the whisky in their 'Black and White' blend.

However, following an economic downturn in the whisky market, Lowrie experienced some difficulty selling matured whisky. The distillery was rebuilt in 1909 following a disastrous fire which ravaged the malt barn and mash house. Closing in 1985, Convalmore was sold to United Distillers in 1987. Change in ownership in part has led to no further whisky being made.

Cragganmore

Phonetic Pronunciation: Crag-an-mor

Location: Speyside

Flavour + Characteristics: Leather / Spiced Berry Jam / Soft Smoke

Brief History:

One of the original classic malts, and one of the first distilleries to have its liquid classed as A1 by blenders. The name takes its inspiration from the rock faces of the mountain which shadow the distillery.

Drawing water from the Craggan Burn near the distillery, Cragganmore is a lightly peated malt with a reputation of one of the most complex single malts of the Strathspey region.

DAILUAINÉ

Phonetic Pronunciation: Dal-yew-in

Location: Speyside

Flavour + Characteristics: Fruit Cake / Buttery / Almond

Brief History:

From the Gaelic meaning green valley. In 1889 Dailuaine was the first distillery to be fitted with a pagoda roof. When a fire raged through the building in the early 1900's this wonderful piece of architecture was lost.

Only 2% of the produced whisky is used for single malt bottling, the rest is used for the Johnnie Walker Blends. A favourite amongst dry sherry lovers for its rich fruit flavour.

DALWHINNIE

Phonetic Pronunciation: Dal-win-eee

Location: Highlands

Flavour + Characteristics: Sticky Figs / Oaked Honey / All Spice

Brief History:

Dalwhinnie in Gaelic has the meaning "the meeting place". The reintroduction of modern worm tubs faces the visitor entrance to the distillery and helps craft the unique texture that is known as the gentle spirit.

Set in the heart of Cairngorms National Park, Dalwhinnie is the highest distillery in Scotland at an altitude of 351m above sea level.

Phonetic Pronunciation: Duff-ton

Location: Speyside

Flavour + Characteristics: Orchard Fruits / Honey / Cereals

Brief History:

The saying goes, Rome was built on seven hills, Dufftown stands on seven stills. Predominantly bottled under the Singleton Brand, for the UK and European market.

Until the opening of Roseisle, the Dufftown was Diageo's largest. with uniquely larger spirit stills than wash stills. The water source, the Jock's Well has been highly disputed with its neighbour Mortlach diverting water its way.

Location: Speyside

Flavour + Characteristics: Green Apple / Cut Grass / Ripe Pear

Brief History:

One of three distilleries under the Singleton Brand. Glendullan is primarily made exclusively for the American Market. The 2007 revamp of the Glendullan brand also houses a bio-plant, cutting carbon footprint, recycling waste bio-degradable solids which boosts the surrounding environment.

A perfect whisky for those who don't like whisky!

Phonetic Pronunciation: Glen-elg-in

Location: Speyside

Flavour + Characteristics: Tiramisu / Salty Butter / Walnut

Brief History:

Previously a member of Diageo's "Hidden Malts" which was released at the start of the century. Only since 1950 has the distillery has any form of electricity. Before that it ran solely of Paraffin, with an expansion in the 1960's.

Originally opened in 1900 but closed after only 5 months. The distillery itself is situated near the curiously named hamlet of Fogwatt.

GLENKINCHIE

Phonetic Pronunciation: Glen-kin-chee

Location: Lowlands

Flavour + Characteristics: Heather / Cut Grass / Honeydew

Brief History:

Located southeast of Edinburgh in Pencaitland, which is often described as being the garden of Scotland. Full of green pastures and hedgerows, the distillery itself is graced with incredibly fertile land.

This garden style distillery has the appearance of a Gin distillery, very unlike any other distillery, it is very approachable to the non-whisky drinker.

Location: Speyside

Flavour + Characteristics: Apple Sorbet / Grassy / Citrus Lollipop

Brief History:

Whilst being one of the rarest seen single malt bottlings, Glenlossie has fourteen warehouses that are home to over 250000 maturing whisky casks at any one point in time, from across the blending portfolio that makes up Johnnie Walker.

Bottles are becoming rarer and rarer, as the parent company of Glenlossie has yet to reveal plans for the future.

GLEN ORD

Phonetic Pronunciation: Glen-orrd

Location: Highlands

Flavour + Characteristics: Green Grass / Crystallised Ginger / Clementine

Brief History:

One of three distilleries under the Singleton brand, and also one of only three distilleries in Scotland to be entirely self-sufficient. Today, Glen Ord produces malt for all northern distilleries which make up Johnnie Walker.

The single malt made here is heavily promoted in the Asian market and is one of the most under rated malt whiskies in Scotland.

Phonetic Pronunciation: Glen-spay

Location: Speyside

Flavour + Characteristics: Greengage / White Grapes / Green Pea-Pods

Brief History:

The Scots Pines beside the ruins of Rothes Castle provide an ideal habitat for the Goldcrest, Scotland's smallest bird and overlook the Glen Spey.

Known for its distinct pine notes, that bring out an oily character. Glen Spey isn't often seen as a single malt bottling, with the Flora and Fauna series being the last known produced not being used for blending.

HAIG

Phonetic Pronunciation: Heyg

Location: Lowlands

Flavour + Characteristics: Popcorn / Coconut Water / Sponge Cake

Brief History:

The first records of Haig Club dates back to the 1600's. Haig has a history not only in grain whisky production but also the design of stills itself, through generational innovation.

Most recently in 2014, redesigned and re-imagined for modern times, fronted by popular figures, Haig has always been important for blending Johnnie Walker. Haig is designed to be mixed, much like gin or vodka.

INCHGOWER

Phonetic Pronunciation: Inch-gow-ur

Location: Speyside

Flavour + Characteristics: Stem Ginger / Salted Chocolate / Cashew Nut

Brief History:

Only one percent of whisky from Inchgower is bottled as single malt. That incredibly small amount is because of the popularity from blenders. Inchgower has the ability to stitch together other whisky with its nutty and spicy aura.

The oyster catcher bird on the front of the bottle is a common sight around the distillery, and a representation of the unique salty quality in the spirit.
