The only operational Scottish malt distillery which uses a hammer mill and mash filter. The use of technology, installed in the year 2000, removes the need for a mash tun.

The production of ultra-clear wort, along with fatter stills is the main contributor to the oily and fragrant character of Teaninich. Counted as a workhorse of a distillery, producing lots of malt whisky for Johnnie Walker blends.

Auchroisk is actually one of the first examples of "finishing" with the ten year old single malt being decanted into ex-sherry casks for a further two years.

Since 1892 Strathmill has been using a long fermentation regime to help create fruitiness, with the use of a purifier running from the lyne arm into the body of the spirit stills adds the distinctive light oily character.

Keith, the unofficial start of the Scotch whisky trail, that has a long history of milling. Strathmill is a distillery that has been converted from one of those old mills.

An intriguing distillery on the lower slopes of the sentinel mountain, the complex distillation process using six stills and a worm tub has been simplified over the last century, whilst retaining its unique character.

One of the oldest legal whisky making sites in Scotland, located near the picturesque tourist hotspot of Pitlochry. Most of the liquid at Blair Athol is aged in ex-borbon barrels, primed for blending.

The few single malt bottlings available however, are mostly aged in ex-sherry casks. With a short fermentation, cloudy worts with the body coming from distillation.

Long ferments, a rake and plough mash tun along with slow distillation allow for an airy, comforting aromatic profile.

The liquid itself is unique due to the versatility of the stills, allowing for vast expressions of whisky to be made.

Only recently re-opened since its closure in 1983, this cult distillery, the original Clynelish, has undergone various levels of production and ownership since inception. Thus the whisky produced over time has been hugely diverse but still all contain the unique tropical-maritime notes with different levels of peat smoke.

Once Scotland's largest distillery. This Lowland whisky is made from grain, originally in one Coffey still with two pot stills installed to produce more Irish-style grain whisky.

Though now closed a distillery, the last bottling was in 1986. Any releases after this date are few and far between. After renovation, only the chimney stack remains as one of the tallest Victorian towers remaining in Scotland.

Glasgow's Port Dundas sits at the highest point in the city, and was once a powerhouse of a distillery. At one point producing over two million gallons a year with approaches we would today label as innovative.

Although several fires hampered the production of grain whisky here, the distillery survived until 2010 with the development of Cameronbridge.

Port Ellen has achieved legendary status amongst connoisseurs in the know, with the magic and mystique growing with age since the distillery's closure in 1983. Quite different to the rest of its neighbours on Islay, most bottlings have been matured in refill oak, it is rare to find a large amount oak in Port Ellen whisky. The eagerly anticipated re-opening of this icon of whisky is scheduled for 2024, to much media attention.

Formerly known as Cameron-Brig, this is the largest grain distillery in Europe, providing whisky for many blends. This often overlooked distillery has a rich history when it comes to grain whisky, intertwining with the Haig brand.

Expansion since 2007 has meant that Cameronbridge is integral to not only Johnnie Walker, but also being home to one of the worlds iconic gin brands, Tanqueray.

Although Caol Ila receives the same spec of malt as sister distillery Lagavulin, Caol Ila's distillation regime which is longer fermentation, higher cut point and taller stills all attributes to its unique properties.

The Gaelic translation of Caol Ila is "Sound of Islay". It is no wonder why this distillery has a cult following, making Caol Ila one of Scotland's most visited distilleries

Originally intended to be the sister distillery of Dufftown, providing a base malt for blended whisky. The distillery only operated for two decades before closing in 2002.

The last remaining stocks are the first ever to be finished in first fill bourbon casks. The dwindling stocks are as rarely sighted as the shy capercaillie, a bird occasionally spotted in the Scottish pine forests surrounding the old distillery.

Oban produces significantly less whisky than it actually could. This is to maintain its character. Onion shaped stills, wormtubs that only run a few days a week, give Oban a characterful lightly-peated personality.

The name Clynelish is an anglicised version of the Gaelic meaning green pastures.

Using a unique distilling regime, which boasts the spirit as distilled 2.81 times. The result of this is a meatier spirit, which adds prized weight to blended whisky, which in turn meant that single malt bottlings were rare, until 2014.

Drawing water from the Craggan Burn near the distillery, Cragganmore is a lightly peated malt with a reputation of one of the most complex single malts of the Strathspey region.
