Taster lessons form an integral part of our year-long access programme for Year 10-11 students from non-selective state schools. Across the year, we aim to boost students' aspirations and attainment with the goal of increasing the likelihood of participants making a successful application to a highly selective university.

ABOUT THE ROLE

Taster class tutors provide participants with an authentic experience of studying their subject at undergraduate level. Successful taster lessons are interactive, informative, and accessible. They challenge students to try a subject they may have never studied before, or to experience what studying a subject they already enjoy would be like at university. The course is supported by a volunteer team who provide pastoral care to the students.

We provide support and resources to help tutors plan their taster lessons and advice on engaging and managing students during lessons.

Main Duties

- Design and deliver an hour-long university taster lesson to two classes of students
- Engage every student and help them to get the most from the class
- Provide good classroom management appropriate to Year 11

- Teaching will take place in person at our partner colleges in Oxford or Cambridge
