We are looking for you to take on a tutoring role guided by the students' revision interests, which will be curriculum based and provided in advance. The course is supported by a volunteer team who provide pastoral care to the students.

- Create a positive and interactive online learning experience
- Prepare suitable revision materials in advance or have recommendations to make
- Engage every student and help them to get the most from the class
- Provide good classroom management appropriate to Year 11
