We work with **Year 10/11 students from non-selective state schools**, helping to boost their attainment and aspirations on **our year-long programme**.

IS THIS THE RIGHT VOLUNTEERING ROLE FOR ME?

Our Course Directors must be confident, committed, and adaptable people who are **experienced in leading teams and working with young people.** This can be an intensive but hugely rewarding role, so Course Directors should be **enthusiastic** and **great at motivating others**.

WHAT DOES VOLUNTEERING WITH UNIVERSIFY INVOLVE?



- Direct a 1-week summer course in Oxford/Cambridge in August 2023
- **Direct a 3-day spring residential** in Oxford/Cambridge in March/April 2024
- Pre-course training 8.5 hours, covering coaching and safeguarding training, with additional ad hoc training sessions throughout the year
- Option to provide hour-long monthly online coaching sessions with up to

As a Course Director you will manage a team of Group Leaders and Volunteer Coaches (who are current or recent undergraduate or graduate students) to ensure the smooth delivery of the course.

Our Course Directors **organise the residential programmes** by liaising with the Programme Team and delegating activities to Group Leaders. You will **motivate, enthuse and support your on-course team** so that courses are high quality, exciting and rewarding both academically and socially.

You will be the primary source of contact for student and volunteer welfare and disciplinary matters, coordination and administration.

MAIN DUTIES

- Manage a team of Group Leaders and Volunteer Coaches
- Oversee the running of all aspects of the course, including managing a budget
- Bond and lead a cohesive team of volunteers
- Manage day-to-day relations with the conference and events staff on-site
- Decision maker in challenging and unexpected situations, including dealing with disciplinary and welfare issues
- Coach 2-3 students via monthly calls for a year, helping to set and achieve academic goals (optional)

WHAT SKILLS WILL I LEARN?

Being a Course Director will challenge you to think on your feet, adapt and communicate plans in a dynamic environment and manage a large team of young volunteers.

You will receive **specialist training in coaching, mentoring and child safeguarding** and receive coaching support on the residential courses and throughout the year.

In addition to the skills and experience you will gain through the programme, we run an opt-in full-year training programme to further improve your employability skills. You will have the option of becoming a



certified Mental Health First Aider as well as developing your coaching skills and your understanding of working with young people.

PRACTICAL DETAILS

- Voluntary: we will cover course-related expenses and travel to and from residentials (within the UK)
- Accommodation: you will be given accommodation on-site in the college
- **Meals:** all meals are provided at the partner college during the residential courses
- There is the option to Course Direct one week or to direct two weeks and to coach no more than 3 students across the two weeks
