WHAT SKILLS WILL I LEARN?

Being a member of our residential volunteer team will challenge you to think on your feet, act as a consistent role-model for young people, and engage with a wide variety of people from different backgrounds.

You will receive **training in child safeguarding** and work with experienced Course Directors during the residentials.

PRACTICAL DETAILS

- Voluntary: we will cover course-related expenses and travel to and from residentials (within the UK)
- Accommodation: on residentials, we will provide some accommodation. Priority goes to Course Directors, Group Leaders and people coming from outside Oxford and Cambridge
- Meals: all meals are provided at the partner college during the residential courses
