ABOUT THE ROLE

As a **Subject Specific Tutor** you will be responsible for providing subject specific GCSE revision classes to a small group of Year 11 students who attended our university access course in summer 2022. We are looking for you to take on a tutoring role guided by the students' revision interests, which will be curriculum based and provided in advance. The course is supported by a volunteer team who provide pastoral care to the students

Main Duties

- Create a positive and interactive learning experience
- Prepare suitable revision materials in advance or have recommendations to make
- Engage every student and help them to get the most from the class
- Provide good classroom management appropriate to Year 11

Practical details

- **Pay:** £30 per hour of teaching + an extra hour per day of teaching for planning up to 2 hours per weekend
- Please mention in the application form if you are travelling from outside Oxford or Cambridge. We are able to give contributions towards travel and/or accommodation costs.
- Teaching will take place in-person at our partner colleges at the University of Oxford or Cambridge
