Taster class tutors provide participants with an authentic experience of studying their subject at undergraduate level. Successful taster lessons are interactive, informative, and accessible. They challenge students to try a subject they may have never studied before, or to experience what studying a subject they already enjoy would be like at university.

We provide support and resources to help tutors plan their taster lessons and advise on engaging and managing students online.

Main Duties

- Design and deliver an hour-long university taster lesson, either remotely on Zoom or in-person on our courses
- Engage every student and help them to get the most from the class
- Provide good classroom management appropriate to Year 10
