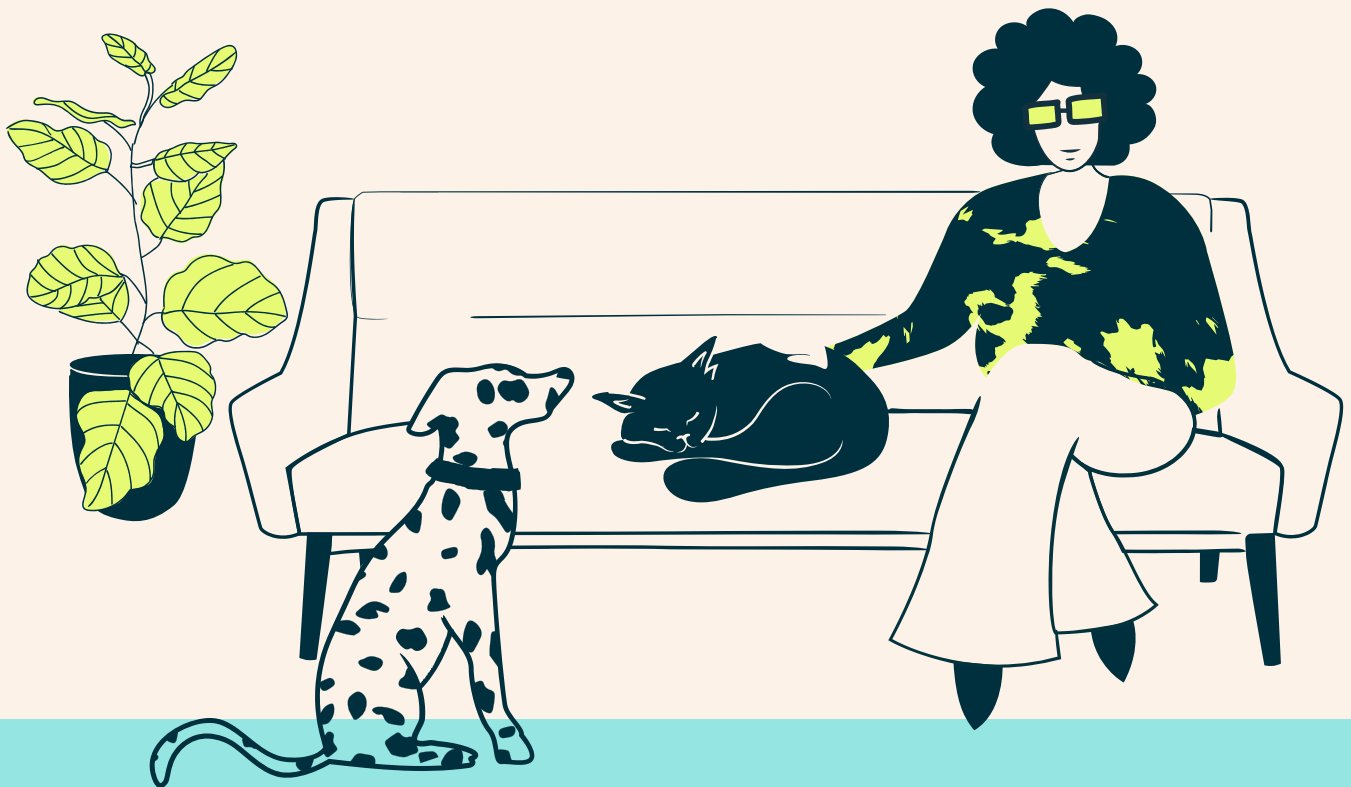




Your Pet's *Legacy Plan*

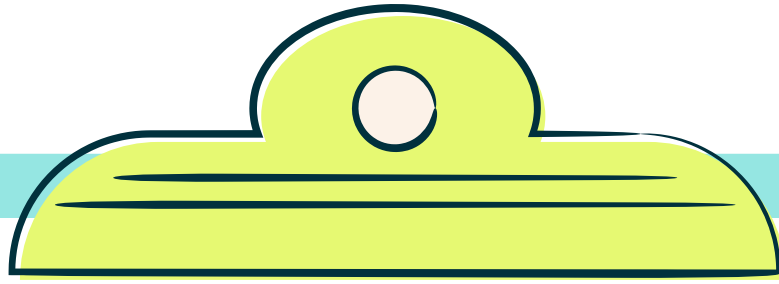

What's Next?

- 1 Get that notary signature. It's what makes all this legally binding (and gives you peace of mind).
- 2 Cut out the emergency wallet card on the final page so your pet's info is always on you.
- 3 Have a money talk with your bank or financial guru to make sure your plans are in order. Share a copy of this document if needed.
- 4 Tell your loved ones about your plan and share this document with them if needed.
- 5 Give a copy to your vet (They'll be impressed, trust us).
- 6 Hand copies to your personal representative and any other legal entities involved in your estate (like your Power of Attorney).
- 7 Create a digital version by snapping a picture or scanning this document, emailing it to yourself, or saving it in your favorite cloud storage. That way, your pet's information is always at your fingertips.
- 8 Mark your calendar, set an alert, tie a string around your finger—whatever it takes to remember to update the roadmap annually, so it stays up to date. Our preferences change, and so do our pets.
