Overall Purpose of Job:	
<p>To assist in the delivery of training for Youth Academy teams. By adopting the coaching philosophy and values of Aberdeen Football Club, this position primarily focuses on the development of individual youth players within a team environment.</p> <p>This role will involve guiding players through the club’s performance environment and helping individuals fulfil their potential, whilst supporting the Lead/ assistant Coach at specified age groups.</p>	
Main Responsibilities/Description of Duties:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To deliver high standard of coaching to an allocated age group and educating youth players in the Academy playing style through the coaching cycles and tactical playbook. • To plan, prepare and deliver/attend as per required. • To work with lead/ assistant coach in the planning preparation and delivery of individual training programmes. • To represent the club professionally at high level European academy tournaments when required. • To coach alongside a Lead/ assistant Coach at weekly weekend Club Academy Scotland fixtures. • Support the Lead Coach to ensure all weekly mandatory data is completed on ‘Kitman Labs’ online management system. • To ensure all players are receiving regular and honest feedback on their development throughout the season, whilst managing expectation levels. • To support the decision-making process in regard to a player’s potential to progress to the next stage of the Youth Academy or to exit the programme. • Review team match footage and analysis videos and provide feedback where necessary. • Complete Continuous Professional Development (CPD) to maintain coaching qualifications. • To attend a personal coach development review meeting with the Head of Academy Coaching annually. • To assess trialists at both training and games and communicate your thoughts to full time staff. • To assist and work alongside Sport Scientists at matches and training sessions. • To ensure that all Academy players adhere to the Players Code of Conduct and show a high level of respect and discipline. • To adhere to the Aberdeen Football Club staff & coaches Code of Conduct. • To attend Sports First Aid or Child Protection courses as required. • To be aware of and comply with the Aberdeen Football Club Social Media Policy. • To educate and develop the young players in a healthy lifestyle and help develop life skills.
