Overall Purpose of Job:	
The Physiotherapist will support both the Boy's and Girl's Academy along with Women's First Team as and when required. <u>Matchday</u> - To provide physiotherapy cover for Academy fixtures as and when required based on the age-group fixture lists. - The Academy has teams represented from Under 10's – 17's age-groups, that play within the Club Academy Scotland, Elite National Fixture Program. <u>Academy Clinic</u> - To provide physiotherapy cover for the Academy Physiotherapy Clinic which runs on a Mon-Fri evening as and when required based on the clinic schedule.	
Main Responsibilities/Description of Duties:	
<u>Matchday</u> - To provide physiotherapy cover for Academy matchdays, including any physical preparation (strappings etc.) and emergency care during matches. - To ensure medical bags remain adequately stocked. - To refer injured players to the weekly youth physiotherapy clinic when appropriate. - To liaise with the main Academy Physiotherapist regarding player handover and rehabilitation progress. - To safeguard registered academy players and report any welfare issues. <u>Academy Clinic</u> - To assess, treat and design rehabilitation programs for academy players presenting with injury to the evening physiotherapy clinic. - Maintain accurate and comprehensive clinical records in accordance with professional and club standards. - Provide communication regarding injury status with parents, coaching staff and academy physiotherapist. - Provide first aid and pitch side emergency cover for training sessions. <i>Please note that this job description is not designed to cover a comprehensive list of activities, duties or responsibilities that are required of the employee for this role.
