# WHAT DOES INTERIOR DESIGN COVER?

### **LAYOUT**

The layout of a project is the positioning of equipment, furniture, and objects, whether fixed or mobile, in the space that is being designed.

### **FURNITURE**

Furniture directly influences the quality of any interior design project. It is the designer's job to ensure the choices will work and function in the space. Attention to the choice of each piece of furniture is crucial.

### **COMFORT & ERGONOMICS**

Comfort covers the aesthetics of the space, the environment it creates, accessibility, and how it is visually perceived. Ergonomics allows spaces to be designed with consideration to the characteristics of inhabitants.

### **MATERIAL & COATINGS**

The composition of each material and the effect this has on the environment. Factors such as origin, durability and recyclability come into play.




3D perspective drawings and floor plan with soft and hard finishings.

### Do I need any prior experience?

You do not need any prior experience. You are expected to have basic computer skills and an interest in Interior Design.

### How many NZQA credits will I gain?

You will gain 7 level 5 NZQA credits, finishing with a level 5 Certificate in Interior Design (Micro-credential). Yoobee is a Category 1 provider, which means you will be receiving the highest tertiary education available.

### Who can enrol?

### What platform is the online teaching run on?

### What equipment do I need?

You are required to have a scale ruler, a general paper supply and range of pencils and fineliners for this course.

### Is there homework?

There is 10 hours of learning per week. 6 of these are contact learning with your tutor, and you are expected to put in an average of 4 hours of self-directed learning per week.

### Where can this course take me?

You will walk away from this course with relevant skills that can be applied to renovations, remodeling, real estate staging, and assisting buyers with decisions about colour and interior decor. There are varying roles in the industry that this course can help you prepare for: Colour Advisor, Showroom Assistant, Home Stager, Interior Stylist, Visual Merchandiser, Interior Design Assistant, Interior Product Sales.
