- A minimum of two passengers required
- Four-seater Cessna Citation Mustang jet (maximum number of guests: 4)

Booking process:

- Rates are net and non-commissionable

Children:

- Children will pay full fare (own seat)
- Infants under 2 years of age on date of travel pay 25% of the full fare (R3 385 One Way and R5 820 return flight
 - on lap, no seat)

Luggage:

- Guests travelling on the Singita Jet Service are entitled to one free piece of checked luggage and one small carry on item.
- Suggested luggage size: 40cm x 30cm x 60cm (16' x 12' x 24'), packed in soft (all-sides) luggage/duffle bags with one flat side.
- Maximum weight: checked luggage 20kg (44lbs); hand luggage 5kg (11lbs)
- Should the luggage exceed the above limitations and Federal Airlines is not able to fit it in the luggage pod, a complimentary luggage storing facility is available at the Federal Airlines Departure Lounge
- To accommodate additional luggage on a flight an additional seat must be booked in advance. Extra luggage allowance 60 kg; size and type of bag(s) as per above.
