Daily game drives with Singita Field Guides provide the perfect opportunity to get up close with Africa's incredible wildlife, with evening drives revealing the elusive magic of nocturnal Africa, always ending with a perfect sunset. Our game drives are all conducted in state-of-the-art safari vehicles, each accommodating a maximum of six guests.

Walking safaris are an incredible way to experience the bush up close. An expert Field Guide will accompany guests as they track animals on foot through the wilderness. Enjoy magnificent landscapes and their beautiful plant and animal species from an intimate perspective during these aweinspiring experiences in nature. We suggest a minimum age of 16 years for this activity, but participation is at the discretion of the Field Guide.

Hot air ballooning

Singita guests can experience the Serengeti from an elevated viewpoint aboard a hot air balloon. Partnering with our preferred supplier in the region, Serengeti Balloon Safaris, this experience offers guests a unique way to experience the Serengeti at sunrise.





Bird watching

There is a variety different of bird species at Singita Serengeti and the area is a bird watcher's dream. Guests can engage with the Field Guides at the lodge to learn more about the birds in the area.

Stargazing

There is no more transcendent experience than looking up at a full sky of sparkling stars. With minimal light pollution and no city lights, the views of the stars are crystal clear.

Swimming

Singita Serengeti House, Milele, and Explore have pools in the main area for guests to enjoy in the exclusive-use homes and camps. Singita Faru Faru has a main pool in the shared guest area, and the two-bedroom suite has a private pool. Singita Sabora Tented Camp and Mara River Tented Camp both have shared pools in the main guest area. Singita Sasakwa Lodge offers heated private plunge pools in all suites, along with a main pool in the shared guest area.

COMMUNITY & CONSERVATION

Community visit

Visit the RISE Centre (Research & Innovation for the Serengeti Ecosystem) with a mission to create innovative tools and solutions to combat the most pressing conservation issues and challenges of our time. RISE aims to develop and support research initiatives that provide tangible and resilient solutions to benefit the people and wildlife of the Serengeti ecosystem and beyond.

Guests can also visit the Grumeti Fund Environmental Education Centre, where local secondary school students and their teachers learn about the critical role each individual plays in minimizing his or her impact on the earth's limited resources. If it is during term time and a class is in session, there may be an opportunity to engage with the students.

Guests will experience various projects pioneered by the Grumeti Fund in the surrounding community such as GHOMACOS (Grumeti Horticultural & Marketing Cooperative Society). GHOMACOS is the agricultural co-operative which the Grumeti Fund helped local farmers to establish. It supplies the Singita lodge kitchens and staff canteens with a constant flow of high-quality, locally grown, organic vegetables, fruits and herbs.
