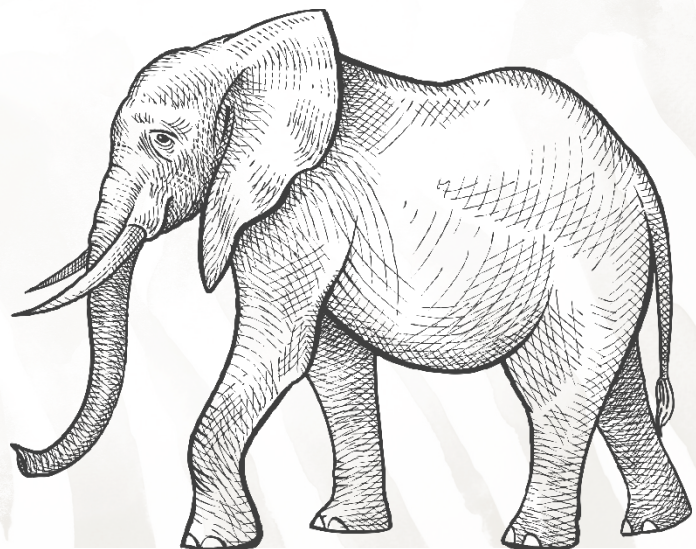
WHAT THE ROLE ENTAILS
