Everything you need to know about travelling to South Africa for a Singita safari right now – from touching down to making your way through customs and health checks: here's how to get to the lodges safely, simply & swiftly.

BEFORE YOU TRAVEL

- All travellers must obtain a negative COVID-19 (SARS-CoV 2 RT-PCR) test, taken 72 hours before departure.
- Please note that other tests, such as Rapid Diagnostics Tests (RDT), are not accepted.

ARRIVAL IN SOUTH AFRICA

- In public areas, it is mandatory to wear a mask and observe social distancing at all times.
- In the airport terminal you will pause at an infrared thermal scanner to check body temperature and an airport official will request your COVID-19 test certificate.
- Proceed through immigration and customs to luggage claim.
- A Federal Air VIP meet and greet service is available to usher you through the airport and transfer to the Federal Air lounge.
- Board Federal Air flight straight to Singita.













AT LODGE

Your health is our top priority and Singita's well-informed measures address all concerns travellers may have surrounding COVID-19.

- Staff are well trained and adhere to strict hygiene protocols, including wearing masks at all times while on duty.
- Social distancing is followed and outdoor activities encouraged.
- Sanitizing stations available throughout with special attention to high-contact areas.

ONSITE TESTING PROTOCOLS

- Private COVID-19 PCR testing available onsite at lodge through Africa Safe-T.
- Certificate processed immediately after test results are received.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

World-class private hospitals and medical facilities are easily accessible in the event of an emergency.
