Singita is a conservation-led ecotourism brand. Guided by an enduring purpose to protect and preserve large areas of African wilderness for future generations, we curate journeys and experiences across some of the continent's most expansive, untouched concessions — striving, always, to inspire a deeper sense of care for nature and for Africa itself.

THE GRUMETI FUND

The **Grumeti Fund** is an independent non-profit organisation. Our conservation partner in Tanzania and the custodian of 350,000 acres of wilderness along the western corridor of the Serengeti, where **Singita Grumeti** is located, its team works tirelessly in the pursuit of a world in which people and wildlife coexist sustainably, forever.

Explore

Camouflaged amongst the tall grass, Explore is one with the plains. Every moment at this pared-back, private camp is guided by the environment. Wind cools you. Heat nudges you towards shade. Curiosity calls you into each unhurried day. You wake to a human voice announcing sunrise, and at night, wildlife calls from the nearby dark. Free to roam, you feel the earth crunch beneath every step, share meals over open flames, and end days trading stories around embers, under star-filled skies. It's simple, yet holds everything you need: a comfortable bed, a warm bucket shower, and those who matter most.

Camp Details

- Two private camps, each comprising six one-bedroom tents.
- Two of these tents (per camp) can be set up to accommodate families, or the additional space can be used for wellness treatments and fitness activities.
- Wi-Fi is available throughout each camp. However, we encourage guests to disconnect and tune into their surroundings as much as possible.
- Each camp is solar-powered, meaning you can charge your devices. The electricity supply is 220V AC.
- Simple, nourishing, seasonal meals cooked over open flames and enjoyed fireside or in the main tent.
- A private vehicle and a small group of people dedicated to guiding every aspect of your stay.
- True to camping, each day is guided by the elements. On hot days, you're cooled by the breeze, a fan, a cold drink, a footbath, an outdoor shower, or a wet kikoi wrapped around you. At night, you're warmed by fire, blankets, and hot water bottles.
- Opportunities for deep rest through meditation, silence, drawing, conversation, and shared learning.
- Children of all ages are welcome.
- Closed between March and May of each year, during the rainy season.

A seemingly endless expanse of teeming plains, riverine forests, thorny scrubland, and rising hills, this concession forms part of the Serengeti-Mara ecosystem. Rich in heritage and biodiversity, it's home to the annual Great Migration, along with an abundance of other endemic and migratory wildlife throughout the year.

Pared-back and private, Explore immerses you in the ecosystem. Life here is slow, spent together around tables and fires, exploring and experiencing the Serengeti from within.

GETTING THERE
