The main role of the Tracker is to manage and deliver a unique game experience to the guests, in line with Singita Service of excellence and SOPs.

- Report to the Head Tracker, Head Guide and Assistant Head Guide.
- Hosting guests and ensuring their preferences and dietaries are respected.
- Always show sensitivity to the environment
- Ensure that safety is a priority.
- Communication with the guiding team and other departmental teams to ensure that guest needs are met, and operations run effectively.
- Maintenance and care of vehicles and equipment.
- Clearing off-road tracks, fallen trees, and overhanging branches from roads.
- Ensuring the quality, cleanliness, functionality and stock of equipment and goods before the

- Cleanliness of the Tracker village and surrounding area, including the wash bay and carports.
- Active participation in and effective communication and support of Singita's conservation message and purpose.
