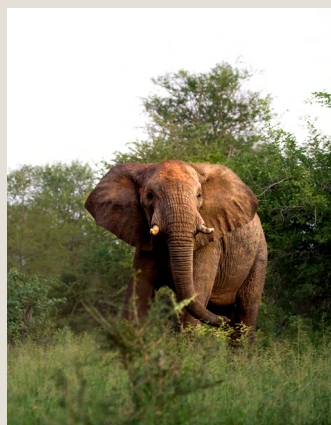
Everything you need to know about travelling to Zimbabwe for a Singita safari right now - from touching down to making your way through customs and health checks: here's how to get to the lodges safely, simply & swiftly.

BEFORE YOU TRAVEL

- All travellers must present a negative COVID19 (SARS CoV 2 RT PCR) test that was taken no longer than 48hrs prior to arrival into Zimbabwe.
- Please note that other tests, such as Rapid Diagnostics Tests (RDT), are not accepted.

ARRIVAL IN ZIMBABWE

- Port Health will conduct screening for CoV 2 and request the test certificate.
- Covid screening documentation will need to be completed.



LODGE

Your health is our top priority and Singita's well-informed measures address all concerns travellers may have surrounding COVID-19.

- Staff are well trained and adhere to strict hygiene protocols, including wearing masks at all times while on duty.
- Social distancing is followed and outdoor activities encouraged.
- Sanitizing stations available throughout with special attention to high-contact areas.

ONSITE TESTING PROTOCOLS

- Testing done on site through Lancet Labs Zimbabwe at a cost of \$75 per person
- Certificate processed within 12hours of test taken. The test will need to be conducted the day before departure from the lodge.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

A new state-of-the-art private hospital is now available in Harare. Transfers to private medical care in South Africa is also possible once all necessary clearances have been obtained.
