



CARBON OFFSETTING PROGRAMME

From 30 August 2021, as part of our ongoing commitment to regenerative tourism, Singita is including a carbon-offsetting levy in each booking, which automatically forms part of each final bill and effectively offsets the carbon footprint of each stay.

How does the
levy work?

Verified carbon credits will be purchased from accredited service providers in each region with the carbon-offsetting levy from each Singita guest.

A balancing act

Carbon offsetting allows guests to balance out their climate impact and compensate for the emissions by reducing CO₂ elsewhere.

Where does
it go?

The contributions fund certified projects that conserve and restore forests, generate clean and renewable energy, and/or increase energy efficiency.

These projects either remove existing carbon from the atmosphere or prevent new emissions.

How is it
calculated?

The average carbon footprint of 1 night's accommodation at Singita was calculated and converted into a carbon-offset cost for every stay.

Estimated current cost/tonne of carbon offset: USD 10/tonne.

One night's offset is currently set at USD 2.33 or ZAR 33 pp/pn.
