SHOWCASING OUTBACK AUSTRALIA

2025 will again be showcasing rugged outback Australia. Departing from Adelaide the first port of call is Quorn. The Autumn colours of outback SA will be on full display as you traverse private tracks and take on all the challenges associated with travelling in remote Australia.

The 2025 OZ Outback Odyssey will be both challenging and rewarding. Here are some of the highlights:

- ★ Quorn is the terminus of one of the state's most popular tourist trains and has more than a dozen heritage listed buildings.
- ★ The town that has been the backdrop from many Hollywood blockbusters and is the birthplace of one of the States most revered footballers, Fos Williams.
- ★ Spend time in the remote Station now used to help at risk youth involved in Operation Flinders in the Gammon Ranges.
- ★ The destocked Yankaninna Station was bought by Operation Flinders Foundation in 2009 – just after the 10 year drought.
- ★ Then it's off to a town that's only been recognised for just over 40 years. Glendambo has population of around 30 people and an annual rainfall of only 185 mm. There's a caravan park, a hotel-motel, a licensed restaurant, roadhouse and general store.

★ This is truly a trip through some of South Australia's most incredible outback destinations via some of the state's most challenging tracks, before arriving in Streaky Bay.

★ This west coast destination is well known for its distinctive environment and picturesque landscape featuring large granite boulders, hoop pines, sandy beaches and fringing coral reefs.

EXPLANATION OF FEES

CREW FEES

Per person crew fees cover all meals and camping / permit expenses on the event as follows;

MEALS

Your meal ticket includes all meals from lunch Wednesday 2nd – Saturday 5th April (including the final presentation dinner in Streaky Bay).

CAMPING / PERMITS

The cost of camping and permits at various towns on the journey are included in your crew fee.

Limited accommodation is available on the event due to the remoteness of destinations. If accommodation is preferred over camping then this will be at the expense of the entrant and you will need to book and pay. You will also need to book and pay for your own accommodation at the final destination, Streaky Bay.

MERCHANDISE PACKAGE

Each entrant / crew fee will include shirt, coffee cup, (brewed coffee daily), commemorative woven patch, stubby holder, insulated water bottle all with the Oz Outback Odyssey label.



HOW DO I ENTER THIS ADVENTURE OF A LIFE TIME?

- The Oz Outback Odyssey welcomes entrants from all over the world.

- If you have paid the non-refundable \$100 hold your spot fee, this will be deducted from the \$1500 deposit.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$1,500 (Inc GST) per vehicle entered is required and payable by 31st December 2024.
- The balance of your fees must be paid by 28th February 2025.

ODYSSEY REGULATIONS

- To be eligible, all Odyssey cars must be 30 years or older. This is defined by: the date of the manufacturer compliance plate as of the 30th of June of the event year.
- Support vehicles must be 4WD - any age.
- All vehicles must have current registration and third party insurance and cars pass scrutineering day.
- All participants, whether in an Odyssey vehicle or a support, must be 18 years or over and must sign an indemnity form.

Australia's most reputable charity, the Royal Flying Doctor Service (RFDS) provides 24/7 emergency aeromedical and essential primary health care services to those who live, work and travel in rural and remote Australia. The RFDS conducts over 100 aeromedical flights of the critically-ill or injured across the country – 15 of these in South Australia every day.

But the RFDS cannot continue its life-saving work for all Australians without the continued support of the community. The RFDS relies on bequests, sponsorships and donations from the community to meet the shortfall in its operational funding and to purchase and medically-equip its 'flying intensive care units' – at a cost of more than \$7 million each.

The RFDS is the major beneficiary of the Oz Outback Odyssey and will receive a minimum 75% of the net proceeds from the event. The Oz Outback Odyssey Committee and the entrants involved have a strong passion for supporting remote communities and have over the years supported the RFDS in various fundraisers at local towns and stations.

The Oz Outback Odyssey is very pleased to be supporting the RFDS as our major beneficiary and we look forward to this partnership continuing well into the future.

The 2024 Odyssey to Magnetic Island, despite a smaller than average field, will live long in the memories of all attendees.
