

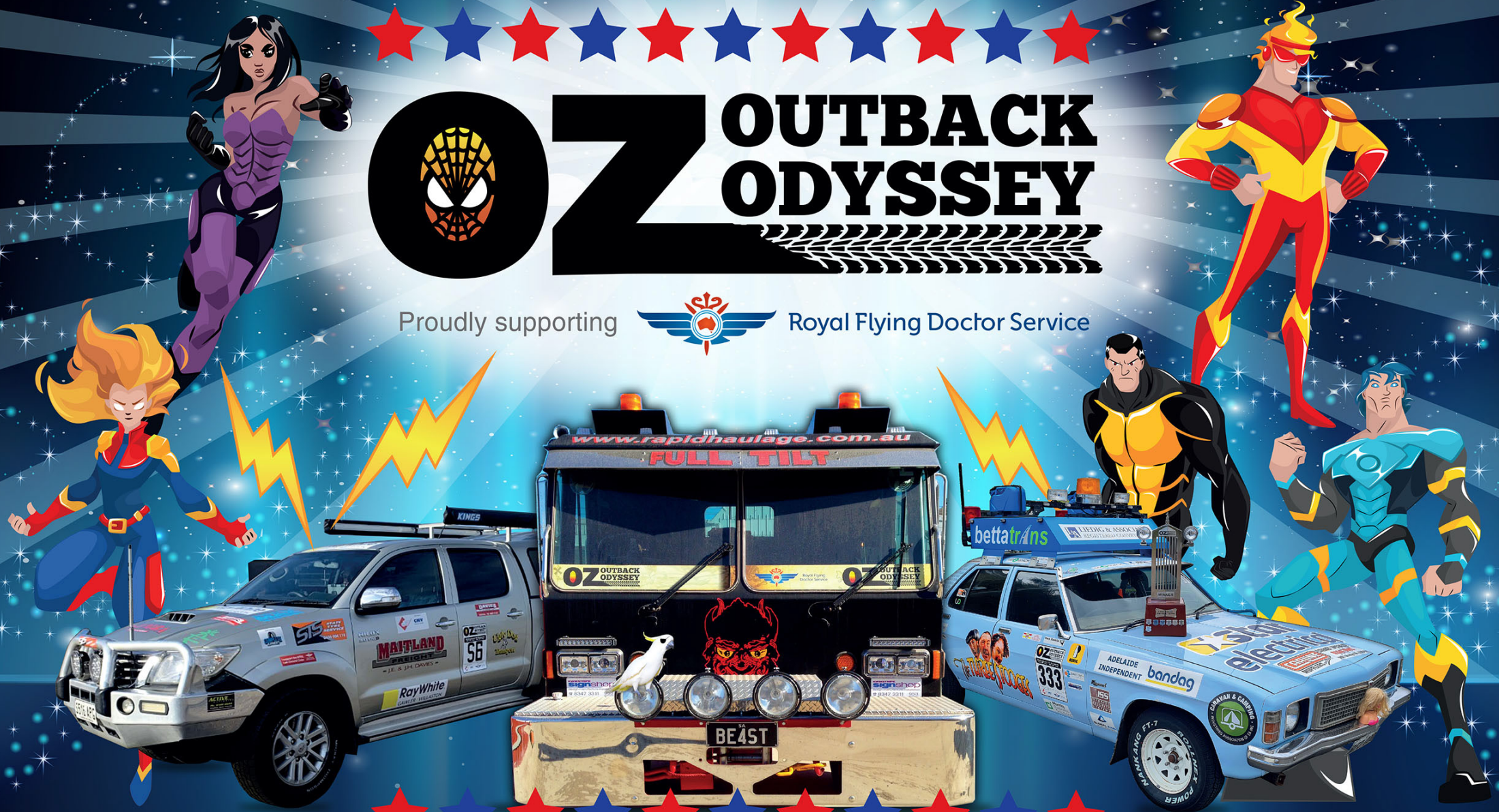

The iconic OZ Outback Odyssey is an event like no other. As South Australia's premier event for car enthusiasts and adventurers alike, it provides a truly unique outback experience that you will remember forever!

2022 is the 29th year of this unique event which packs a life-time of experiences of travelling through the Australian Outback into one awesome week as entrants traverse rugged, spectacular and remote regions of Australia in Odyssey cars that are 30 years old at the start of the event and 4WD support vehicles.

What's more, you will be raising funds for a fantastic cause! The Royal Flying Doctor Service (RFDS) is the major beneficiary of the OZ Outback Odyssey. Our event is proud to be raising funds for the RFDS to help this fantastic organisation continue its vital work providing a life-saving, invaluable service to regional and remote Australia. In 2022 the event aim is to raise in excess of \$200,000 for the RFDS.

2022 will again be showcasing rugged outback Australia. Departing from Kings Creek Station in the Northern Territory the event will travel the iconic Tanami track across to Halls Creek up to Cape Leveque and finish in the popular pearling fishing town of Broome Western Australia.

Support cars must be 4WD and can be of any age. They can be entered either as an independent or in association with an Odyssey Car.

*Note that it is not mandatory for an Odyssey Car to have a Support Car.

FUNDRAISING FOR THE RFDS

In 2022, with the help of our entrants, the OZ Outback Odyssey aims to raise in excess of \$200,000 for the Royal Flying Doctor Service. Whilst the fees are the minimum requirement, all entrants are encouraged to raise additional funds to donate to the RFDS cause. We have had fantastic additional support via entrant fundraising in the past. When requested, the RFDS will assist you to coordinate your personal online fundraising page where donations can be made online by participants family, friends and colleagues and receipts can be issued immediately.

EXPLANATION OF FEES

CREW FEES

Per person crew fees cover all meals and camping / permit expenses on the event as follows;

MEALS

Your meal tickets includes all meals from lunch Thursday 28th July – Saturday 6th August (including the final presentation dinner in Broome).

CAMPING / PERMITS

The cost of camping and permits at various towns on the journey are included in your crew fee.

Limited accommodation is available on the event due to the remoteness of destinations. If accommodation is preferred over camping then this will be at the expense of the entrant and you will need to book and pay. You will also need to book and pay for your own accommodation at the final destination Broome.

MERCHANDISE PACKAGE

Each entrant / crew fee will include shirt, coffee cup, (brewed coffee daily), commemorative woven patch, stubby holder, face mask, insulated water bottle all with the Oz Outback Odyssey label.



HOW DO I ENTER THIS ADVENTURE OF A LIFE TIME?

- The OZ Outback Odyssey welcomes entrants from all over the world.

- If you have paid the non-refundable \$100 hold your spot fee, this will be deducted from the \$1500 deposit.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$1,500 (Inc GST) per vehicle entered is required and payable by 28th February 2022.
- The balance of your fees must be paid by 30th June 2022.

ODYSSEY REGULATIONS

- To be eligible, all Odyssey cars must be 30 years or older. This is defined by: the date of the manufacturer compliance plate as of the 30th of June of the event year.
- Support vehicles must be 4WD - any age.
- All vehicles must have current registration and third party insurance and cars pass scrutineering day.
- All participants, whether in an Odyssey vehicle or a support, must be 18 years or over and must sign an indemnity form.

EVENT BENEFICIARY



Australia's most reputable charity, the Royal Flying Doctor Service (RFDS) provides 24/7 emergency aeromedical and essential primary health care services to those who live, work and travel in rural and remote Australia. On a daily basis the RFDS conducts over 100 aeromedical flights of the critically-ill or injured across the country – 15 of these in South Australia every day.

But the RFDS cannot continue its life-saving work for all Australians without the continued support of the community. The RFDS relies on bequests, sponsorships and donations from the community to meet the shortfall in its operational funding and to purchase and medically-equip its 'flying intensive care units' – at a cost of more than \$7 million each.

The RFDS is the major beneficiary of the OZ Outback Odyssey and will receive a minimum 75% of the net proceeds from the event. The OZ Outback Odyssey Committee and the entrants involved have a strong passion for supporting remote communities and have over the years supported the RFDS in various fundraisers at local towns and stations.

The OZ Outback Odyssey is very pleased to be supporting the RFDS as our major beneficiary and we look forward to this partnership continuing well into the future.

The Committee has the discretion to make payments to local groups during our event each year. During the 2021 event, a donation of \$2,000 was made to the Isolated Children's Parents Association South Australia.
