Dear Commissioner Carlton and Members of the Declaration of Rights Committee of the Constitution Revision Commission:

On behalf of the Public Interest Law Section of the Florida Bar, I am writing to express the Section's support of Proposal 40.

The Public Interest Law Section has had a long-standing interest in protecting the legal needs of children. In 2016, the Section adopted and published a formal position supporting the appointment of attorneys for children who are the subject of abuse and neglect proceedings, to advocate for the children's interests in legal proceedings affecting their placement and needed services.

We believe the proposed amendment is necessary to ensure that the rights of Florida's dependent children are adequately protected and that their needs and well-being are promoted in court proceedings. An expressed-interests attorney for every child, in conjunction with the best interests representation of the Guardian ad Litem Program, will achieve the most effective outcomes for Florida's foster youth.

Accordingly, we believe this proposal should be approved by the Constitution Revision Commission.
