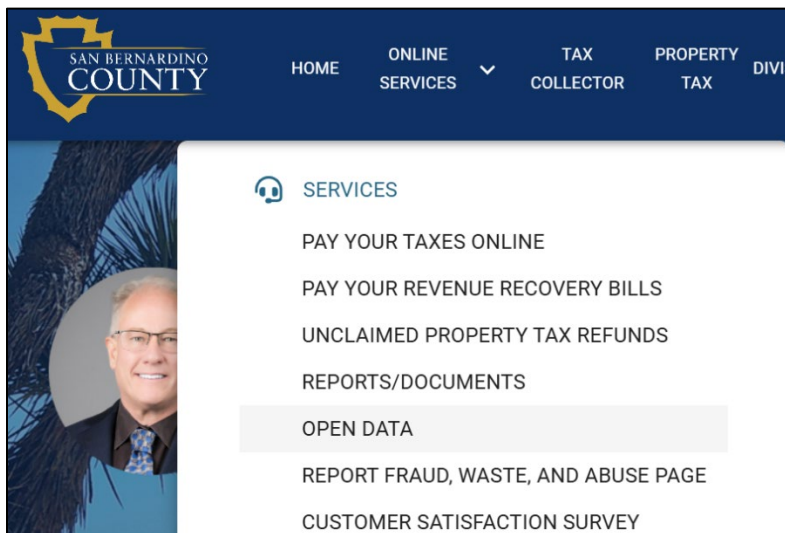

Instructions for San Bernardino County Default Lists

Beginning July 2025, data about delinquent and defaulted taxes is available on San Bernardino County Tax Collector's website for free. First, go to the website at <https://www.sbcountyatc.gov>. Hover over "Online Services" near the top of the screen, then click "Open Data".



Hover over "Data Categories" near the top of the screen, then click "Open DATA".



If you want to research parcels that might be in a tax sale within a year, select “Defaulted Bills > 5 Yrs Old”. If you want to research parcels farther in advance, select “Defaulted Bills 5 Years or Newer”.

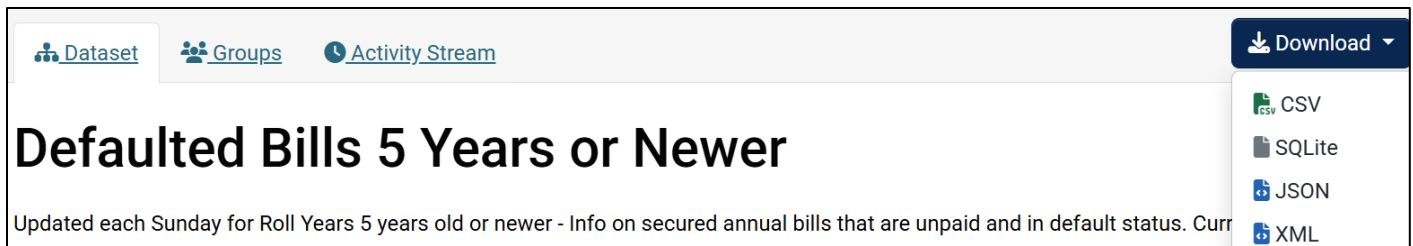

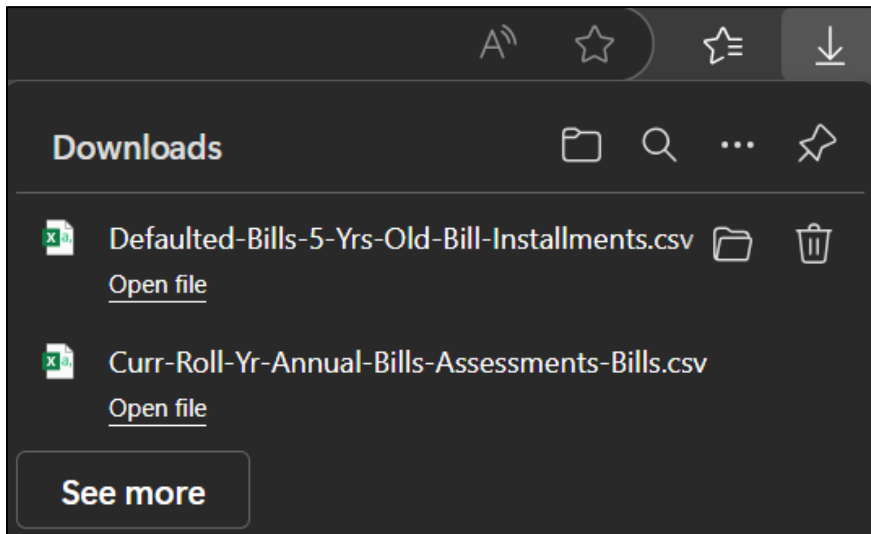
Defaulted Bills 5 Years or Newer

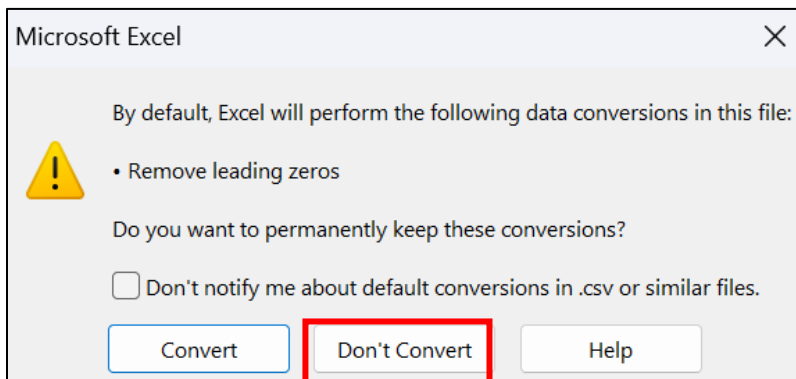
Click the name of the dataset you want to use, then click “Download” and select “CSV”.



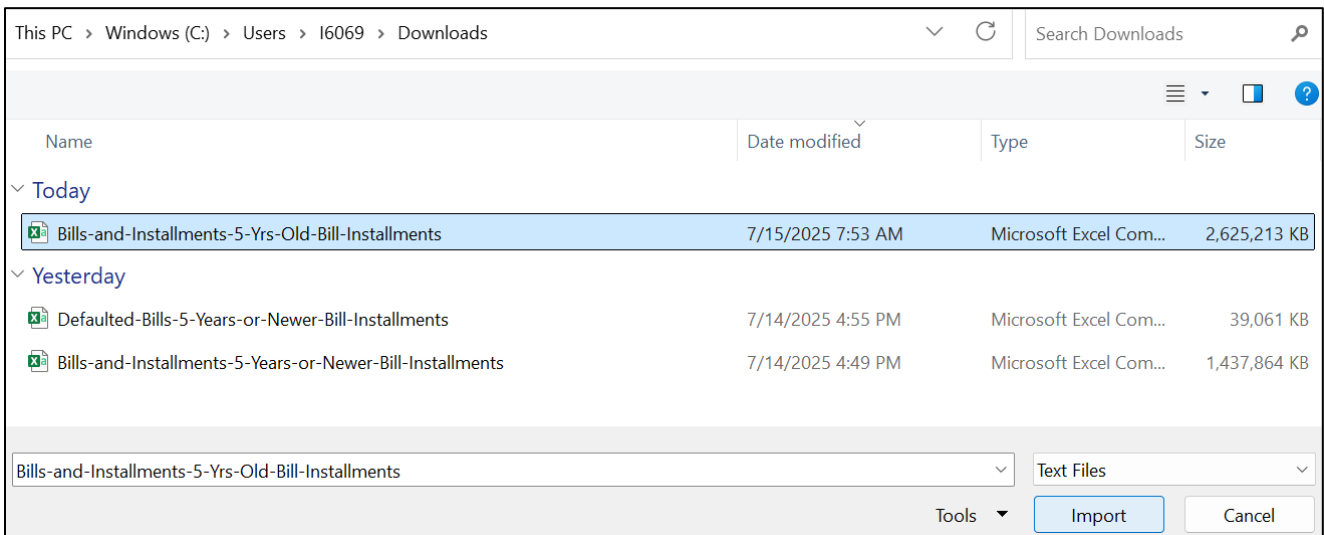
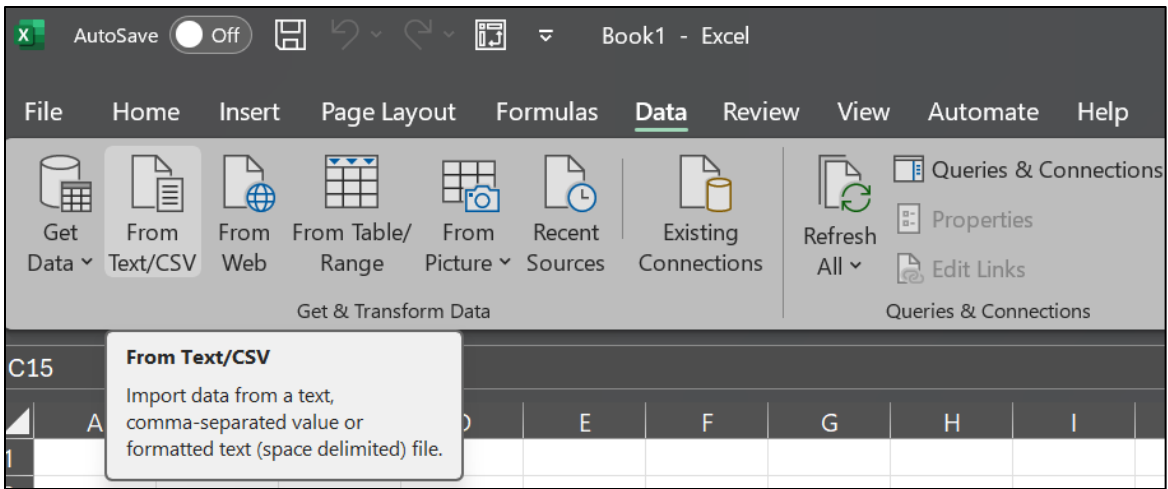
Then open the file from your browser’s Downloads page.



If you get a window asking if you want to remove leading zeros, click “Don’t Convert”. (A lot of account/parcel numbers begin with zero, and converting will mess them up.)



If the CSV file is too large to open the regular way, you can use Excel’s Power Query Editor to filter the data and make the file smaller. First open a blank Excel file, then click the “Data” tab at the top, then click “From Text/CSV”. Select the CSV file in your computer’s Downloads folder, then click “Import”.



Click “Transform Data” at the bottom.
