GLOSSARY OF TERMS

1. Fake Fast pace: Pace analysis tools will be incorrect in this situation because in 'fake fast' situations, pacesetters are **CORRECTLY IGNORED** by riders that identify a 'runoff leader' that is going too fast early. This results in a pack that is running "a race within a race." Don't be too quick to downgrade Closers in such situations!
2. Accordion Flow: An 'accordion flow' is a dynamic that mostly occurs in turf routes. When leaders are successful in "backing down the pace" to catch a breather before sprinting for home, the field can crunch together before stretching out again, sometimes causing traffic issues for the back markers. In the majority of these instances, speed types and ground savers are the runners to benefit.
3. L: This is merely an abbreviation for "length."
4. "Tight" in-between vs "Loose" in-between : In-between racing is common in larger fields. "Tight" in-between positions cause stress and leave runners with tough options: (1) Progress and run the risk of moving too early. (2) Idle to move backwards results in position and ground loss. (3) Remaining in the same spot will likely result in the burning of needed energy.
5. Gapped leaders: Imagine a runoff leader and then (1) or (2) more rivals with a big advantage to the rest of the pack. These leading runners are out of position and chasing a leader that is **VERY LIKELY** going too fast early. Situations with "gapped leaders" offer a **HUGE** advantage to the Closers

He raced 2+W through the far turn and did OK to keep pace through the lane despite receiving a token ride in the last furlong; a decent effort after dealing with some traffic and trouble that go unnoticed in the running line, he takes on more ground today.

A wide trip vs a slow pace, the jockey sees fit to try again in start #2 off the layoff.

TRIP NOTE: ON SYNTHETIC: he did OK to avoid getting stuck obnoxiously wide through the first turn from the far outside post. he traveled 3+W through the clubhouse turn, raced wide on the backstretch and took a 4+W path into the far turn while gaining on the leaders, and after entering the stretch drive 3+W and vying for command through the stretch, did good work to BARELY miss by losing a terrible head bob on the wire. A good performance on the 'synthetic' after a wide journey, he gives turf another try today.

TRIP NOTE: He landed in a good enough spot while following a loose pocket rival from a ground saving position, but in the far turn, the runner that he was following began to stall, and he lost about 2L and key positions as others circled; this was significant trouble that seems understated in the PPs. He finally eased off the rail to get around the stalling rival, found a gap to reach clear sailing while wide in the lane, and finished FULL OF RUN before galloping out in front! A big effort deserves PLENTY of extra credit!

TRIP NOTE: If you ignore the leader that held a big margin early, this runner had actually landed in a 'pocket position' as it related to the rest of the pack; this was a good spot. he rated kindly near the rail on the backstretch, but actually got a bit unlucky when the runner to his outside pulled up, which gave this one's rider the idea to move off of the rail. He moved off the rail and began to gain through the far turn while 3W, and did good work to reach a joint-leading spot with 1F to go, but was slightly outfinished. A neutral trip overall, a new conditioner takes over.

Her inability to completely relax hurt her chances, and the cutback in distance makes sense.

TRIP NOTE: Was 15-1 ML. She was sent along early and showed nice speed, but when a couple of rivals were quicker and moved inward, she was forced to idle and rate. She landed in a good spot and took control of the pocket down the backstretch, protected her spot nicely when urged into the far turn, and after saving ground through the far turn, weakened when she reached the top of the stretch. A useful debut and nice showing of talent from the rail draw on debut, expecting this one to make a hard try for the lead with the blinkers going on.

She advanced when coaxed along on the backstretch and took to the rail approaching the far turn, but when the favorite moved inward, she steadied and lost nearly 3L, which is completely understated in the PPs! The remainder of the race she recovered up the rail, and was game to earn place money. An unlucky loser vs lesser on debut, she takes on much better!
