Instructions

Step 1: Print off the free ice cream printable available below.

Step 2: Have your kiddo practice their fine motor skills and cut out all the ice cream cones and scoops.

Step 3: Encourage them to stack the scoops above the cones to spell out the words.



Age Adjustments

For older preschoolers: Encourage them to find the rhyming words and add to them!

For younger toddlers: If your younger kiddos are cutting out the letters, they may need some hand over hand help with those wavy shapes!

- How many scoops of ice cream are in the word mouse?
- Can you find something around us that starts with this letter?
- What letter do I need to change "sun" to "run"?
- How many letters are in your name?
