Materials

Instructions

Step 1: Print off a sheet of the days of the week for each child.

Step 2: Have the children put their name on one piece of paper and set it to the side.

Step 3: Give the children markers or crayons to color in the words.

Step 4: During this time talk about the days of the week and the order in which they appear.

Step 5: When they are finished, give them scissors to cut out each box that surrounds the word.

Step 6: Let them glue the word down on the piece of paper you set aside.

Step 7: Send home their success for the family to see.
