Ducati Motor Holding – Via Cavalieri Ducati 3 - Bologna

### Car/motorcycle/bus parking

There is ample parking for cars, motorcycles and buses near the company, in Via Cavalieri Ducati. The parking is public, free, unguarded and is 300 metres from the company main entrance.

Visitors arriving on Ducati motorcycles can park inside the company as long as parkings are available. Entrance - Via Cavalieri Ducati 3.

Buses cannot enter the property.

### Check-in and factory tour start

Upon arrival all visitors must check in at the Visitor Desk of the Ducati Reception.

Visitors who have booked the factory tour must arrive at least **15 minutes before** the tour starts and bring a copy of the booking confirmation.

Once the check-in has been completed, all visitors must go to the Visitor Centre to pay the entrance fee.

The Meeting Point for guided tours of the factory is at the Visitor Centre. Visitors must arrive 10 minutes before the tour starts.

**The duration of the guided tour of the factory and museum is 70 minutes.**

### Fees and payment methods

The Factory + Museum ticket is valid for just one visit. Visitors are not allowed to exit through the reception and enter more than once on the same day.

Payments for groups: advance bank transfer to confirm the booking.

## Services available



The following services are available at the Visitors Centre (in addition to the ticket counter):

- Shop
- Restrooms
- Vending machine for drinks
- Lockers for storing small personal items (ask for a key at the ticket counter)

**No luggage room is available, so students are asked to leave their backpacks in the bus.**

## General rules of conduct

During the factory visit it is **mandatory to wear closed-type footwear**. Visitors with open-type footwear will not be allowed into the production area.

It is prohibited to take photographs inside the company, with the exception of the museum.

Minors must be accompanied both in the museum and during the guided tour of the factory.

It is prohibited to eat food inside the museum and during the factory visit.

If you are late, entrance to the factory is not guaranteed.

Animals – even small ones – are not allowed in the factory.

Only small animals are allowed inside the museum, but only if they are held.
