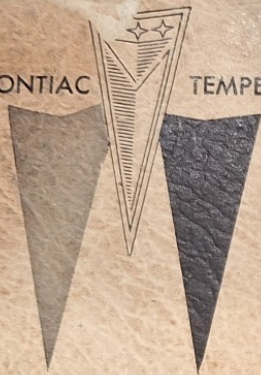

PONTIAC

OWNER PROTECTION PLAN
AND NEW VEHICLE WARRANTY

IMPORTANT

The Owner Protection Plan and the Pontiac New Vehicle Warranty contained herein applies to the Vehicle identified on the Protect-O-Plate attached hereto. For convenience, such Vehicle is referred to at times simply as the Vehicle.

The booklet with the Protect-O-Plate attached must be kept with the vehicle at all times. The Vehicle and this booklet must be made available to an authorized Pontiac Dealer if warranty work becomes necessary, and once every twelve months during the warranty period as part of the warranty maintenance and mileage validation requirement. This requirement also applies to owners other than the original purchaser. Therefore, the booklet and Vehicle Data portion of the Protect-O-Plate must remain with the Vehicle at time of resale.

DATE VALIDATED MILEAGE AT VALIDATION

Under the provisions of the Pontiac New Vehicle Warranty, a record of the required maintenance services must be validated by an authorized Pontiac Dealer twelve (12) months after the original delivery date and each twelve (12) months thereafter during the warranty period. Dealer will furnish a report of such validation to Pontiac Motor Division.

NEW VEHICLE WARRANTY

Pontiac Motor Division, General Motors Corporation, (hereinafter referred to as Pontiac) warrants each new Pontiac passenger car and chassis (hereinafter referred to as a Vehicle) including all equipment and accessories thereon (except tires and tubes), manufactured or supplied by Pontiac and delivered to the original retail purchaser by an authorized Pontiac Dealer, to be free from defects in material or workmanship under normal use and service for 24 months or until it has been driven for 24,000 miles after such delivery, whichever occurs first; and further warrants the power train components specifically described as the cylinder block and head and all internal engine parts, intake manifold, transmission case and all internal parts, torque converter, propeller shaft and universal joints, differential, axle shafts and rear wheel bearings on any such Vehicle, manufactured or supplied by it to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service for 5 years or until it has been driven for 50,000 miles after such delivery, whichever occurs first.

As an express condition of this warranty, once every 12 months the owner is required to furnish an authorized Pontiac Dealer evidence that the engine oil, oil filter, carburetor air filter, and positive crankcase ventilator valve (and automatic transmission oil and transmission band if so equipped) have been serviced in accordance with Pontiac's required maintenance schedule as stated, in the

applicable Pontiac Owner Protection Plan booklet, and have the Dealer certify in such booklet (1) that he has received such evidence, and (2) the then current indicated mileage on the odometer.

Pontiac's obligation under this warranty is limited to repairing or replacing any part or parts which are returned to an authorized Pontiac Dealer at such Dealer's place of business and, which examination shall disclose to Pontiac's reasonable satisfaction to have been thus defective. The repair or replacement of defective parts under this warranty will be made by such Dealer without charge for parts and labor.

The provisions of this warranty shall not apply to any Vehicle which has been subject to misuse, negligence, alteration or accident, or which shall have been repaired outside of an authorized Pontiac Dealer's place of business in any way so as, in the reasonable judgment of Pontiac, to affect adversely its performance and reliability, nor to normal maintenance services (such as engine tune up, fuel system cleaning, carbon or sludge removal, brake and clutch adjustments and wheel alignment and balancing) and the replacement of service items (such as spark plugs, ignition points, positive crankcase ventilator valves, filters and brake and clutch lining) made in connection with such services, nor to normal deterioration of soft trim and appearance items due to wear and exposure.

- TRANSMISSION OIL CHANGE AND ADJUSTMENTS.
- CLEANING OF OIL FILTER CAP.
- CLEANING OR REPLACING OF AIR FILTER ELEMENTS.
- TIRES OR BATTERY (Warranted by original manufacturer).
- TIRE ROTATION.
- FRONT END ALIGNMENT AND WHEEL BALANCE.
- BRAKE CLEANING, BLEEDING OF SYSTEM, SHOE ADJUSTMENT, OR LINING, REPLACEMENT.
- ADJUSTMENTS OF BODY RATTLES OR SQUEAKS due to normal driving or road hazard (Warranted to 60 days).
- ENGINE CHASSIS. Damage due to freeze up or weather hazard.
- DAMAGE TO PAINT, CHROME, OR TRIM due to wear or normal use (defects in paint Warranted to 90 days).
- COOLING SYSTEM CLEANING OR FLUSHING.
- WINDSHIELD WIPER BLADES.
- REPLACEMENT OR ADJUSTMENT OF DRIVE BELTS.
- REPLACEMENT OF POSITIVE CRANKCASE VENTILATION VALVE AND CLEANING OF SYSTEM.

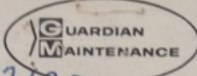

1967 NEW VEHICLE PRE-DELIVERY INSPECTION AND ADJUSTMENT CHECK SHEET

1. LUBRICANT AND FLUID LEVELS

Check for leaks and proper level — repair and replenish as necessary

- Radiator coolant (level and freeze protection)
- Windshield washer (level and solvent)
- Battery (level and state of charge)
- Power steering pump or steering gear
- Brake master cylinder
- Engine oil
- Automatic transmission
- Air conditioning (check sight glass, tighten hose clamps)

2. OPERATIONS WITH CAR RAISED

Inspect and correct as necessary

- Torque: Pitman shaft nut
 Steering gear to frame bolts
 Tie rod clamp bolts (check proper clamp position)
 Idler arm support bolts
 Front and rear suspension lower control arm and rear suspension upper control arm attaching bolts

- Check for cotter pins in castellated nuts on ball joint studs and steering linkage
 - Adjust tire inflation pressure to normal rated load requirements
 - Check differential and manual transmission fluid level
- Inspect for leaks in:
- Engine cooling system
 - Engine
 - Transmission and cooler
 - Brake system
 - Steering gear
 - Fuel system
 - Differential

3. OPERATIONS WITH CAR ON FLOOR

Check and correct as necessary

- Hood primary and secondary latch
- Properly tension all fan and accessory drive belts
- Fully seat coil-to-distributor high tension lead and all spark plug leads
- Set dwell and ignition timing
- Adjust carburetor fast and slow idle speed, mixture and check for fuel leaks. Check throttle linkage for freeness at wide open and closed throttle. Adjust anti-stall diaphragm plunger.
- Headlight aim. Adjust if required.
- Torque wheel nuts
- Torque front suspension upper control arm attaching bolts
- Front wheel toe-in and steering wheel center position. Adjust if required.
- Sun visors (proper tension)
- Rear view mirror (tight)
- Seat track (operation)

- Operation of all seat and shoulder belts
- Operation of door and compartment locks and latches, record key numbers

4. ELECTRICAL

Check operation — correct as necessary

- Head lights
- License plate and back-up lights
- Instrument panel lights
- Temperature, generator, oil pressure lights
- Parking lights
- Neutral safety switch
- Stop and tail lights
- Directional signals
- Emergency flasher
- Parking brake light
- Dome light (door switches)

5. GENERAL APPEARANCE ITEMS

Inspect condition and correct as necessary

- Interior and exterior trim and moldings
- Alignment of hood, doors and lids
- Remove top cover and test operation of convertible top. Check alignment of top and fit of boot.

6. ROAD TEST

Check and correct as necessary

- Performance of engine and transmission
- Throttle controls and transmission switch
- Heater and/or air conditioning
- Operation of service and parking brakes
- W/S wipers and washer
- All accessories
- Steering and handling
- Horns
- Instruments and gauges
- Squeaks and rattles

7. FINAL CLEAN-UP BEFORE DELIVERY

- Clean interior, install floor covering if required or remove protective covering
- Wash car
- Inspect exterior finish, spot paint repair, touch-up, rub out as required and detail clean-up
- Install hub caps or discs

8. OWNER — DEALER — VEHICLE DATA

- Complete Protect-O-Plate
- Complete selling dealer information in Owner Protection Plan booklet
- Review Owner Protection Plan booklet and Owner's Manual with owner
- (A) Explain maintenance schedule and warranty provisions
- (B) Demonstrate operation of all accessories
