The Callaway C12 is the result of the combined efforts of two global companies, Callaway Cars, Inc. and IVM Engineering, Munich, who have joined to form a partnership for the production of this automobile.

Callaway C12 Specifications:

Powered by Callaway's SuperNatural® LS1 engine, the 8-cylinder, twin-valve alloy engine is a hand assembled, blue-printed LS1 engine. With Callaway designed CNC aluminum cylinder heads, pistons, rods, camshaft, modified crankshaft, and heavy duty clutch. Rated power output is at 440 bhp (SAE) @ 6500 rpm with 420 lbs.-ft. of torque @ 4750 rpm, displacement is 5.7 liters. Build plaque and engine dyno sheet included with vehicle.

The brake system utilizes forged aluminum 4-piston calipers designed by Alcon with internally vented and slotted rotors complemented by an anti-lock braking system.

The lightweight aluminum alloy wheels are designed by AZEV. Pirelli has designed a proprietary "run-flat" tire, based on the P Zero series. Measurements are 295/30 ZR19 in front and 295/30 ZR19 rear with an optional 335/25 ZR19.

The C12 employs an individual wheel suspension system with double A-arms and adjustable dampers that have been fitted to both axles, improving the cars stability. Components are hand fabricated and produce a track of nearly two meters.

Designed by Paul Deutschman in conjunction with IVM Design, the body of the Callaway C12 consist of carbon-kevlar matrix for low weight and strength. Components include the hood, fenders and door panels, carbon fiber B-pillar panels, door sill plates, carbon fiber engine cover set, and billet aluminum hood hinge set.

Standard equipment on the Callaway C12 include dual air bags, on-board computer, automatic climate control system, heated exterior mirrors, a windscreen aerial, and deluxe contour seats. The interior is accented with a blend of aluminum, leather, and carbon fiber.

The Callaway C12 is assembled by hand in our facility at Leingarten, Germany and takes twelve weeks to build. The Callaway C12's design philosophy incorporates state-of-the-art design elements, high technology materials and the finest craftsmanship to the world's best standards.
