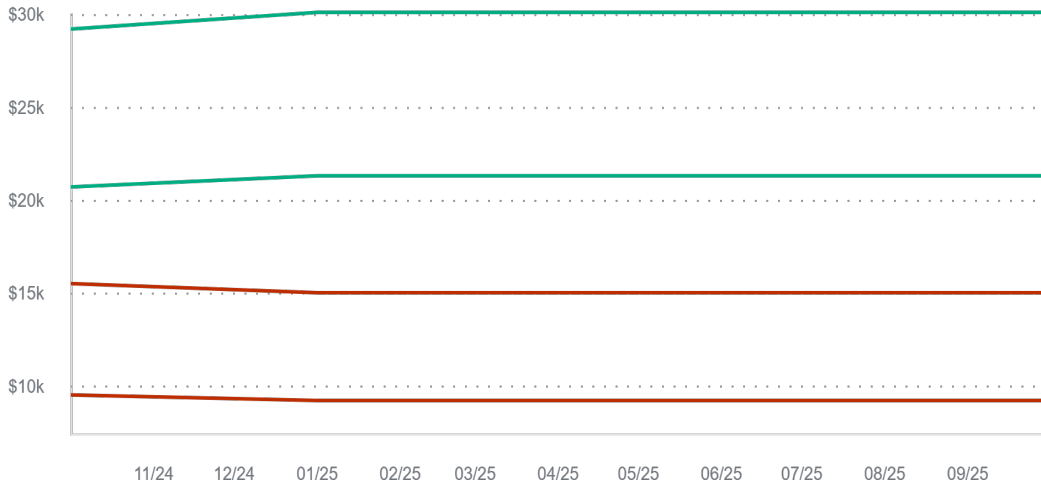

Model description

Oldsmobile's fully redesigned 1968 Cutlass models were built on two wheelbases—112 inches for 2-door "Cutlass S" styles and 116 inches for Cutlass/Cutlass Supreme 4-doors.

Following up on the somewhat quirky 1968 styling, Cutlass designers developed a frontal appearance for '69 that would, with annual variation, mark the popular Cutlass through 1972. Revamped body panels and new rooflines followed in 1970.

While most 1968-72 Cutlass buyers chose the V-8 series' standard 350-cid engine, a very limited number selected the inline six, offered through 1971.
