I, Emanuel Dragone, President of Dragone Classic Motorcars with offices at 5 Connair Road, Orange, Connecticut 06477 attest to the following vehicle ownership history in regards to the 1905 Rambler Type 1, which was recently purchased by Mr. Whalen:


*In 1905, Mr. John Fodor from Norwalk, Connecticut made his first new car purchase at a local dealership in his home town of Norwalk, CT. He purchased a new 1905 Rambler Type 1, VIN#5420 and he would later purchase, a 1911 and 1914 Stanley Steamer, along with a 1911 Mid-land 40HP Roadster to add to his stable. All of these cars, remained in his possession; including the Rambler, until his passing, when his collection was inherited, along with the family farm by his two nephews. In 1992, the Fodor brothers decided to sell the cars to me and my brother and business partner, George Dragone. I dealt primarily, with one of the Fodor brothers, named Mark, who also resides in Connecticut. Mark's uncle's car collection was well known by vintage car collectors, which included a respected local collector named, Louis Biondi. I was good friends with Louis and bought and sold many vehicles to him, one of which, was the 1905 Rambler, as well as, the 1914 Stanley 606 Steamer that I had acquired from Mark and Ronald Fodor in 1992. Since Louis's purchase of the cars, which were stored and cared for properly over the years. The cars had retained the same patina, and remained in the same condition, as when I had originally sold them to Mr. Biondi in 1992. I reacquired them from his estate in 2019.*




