IMPORTANT INFORMATION

BOOKING DATES

When can I book a campsite?

ALL sites for the 2023 Repco Bathurst 1000 have now been sold.

TICKETS AND VEHICLE PASSES

How many vehicle passes do I get per campsite?

You will receive one (1) x vehicle pass per campsite in the **Paddock** campground, and two (2) x passes per campsite in **all other campgrounds**. All vehicles must display a valid access pass to access the campgrounds.

Vehicle passes will be distributed in August 2023 with regular updates sent.

Does my campsite ticket get me access to the Repco Bathurst 1000?

No. You must purchase an admission ticket to the Repco Bathurst 1000 in addition to your campsite ticket. General Admission Tickets are available via Ticketek.

CAMPGROUNDS

What campgrounds are available in 2023?

Subject to availability, campers can book campsites at one of the following 8 campgrounds:

McPhillamy Park Campground

There is no better way to head to the Repco Bathurst 1000 than travelling up the mountain and setting up camp at the McPhillamy Campground. This is where the legends of Bathurst live. Campers come here year after year to show the true spirit of the Repco Bathurst 1000. Located on the top of the great mountain, this campground is near Skyline and the mountain's "Esses". Permanent toilets and showers available on site.

Reid & Sulman Campground

Reid and Sulman Campground is located at the top of the mountain, in the perfect position to watch the cars ascend the mountain and fly across Skyline. Campers come here year after year to show the true spirit of the Repco Bathurst 1000. Permanent toilets and showers available on site.

Max Cameron Campground

The Max Cameron Campground is located at the bottom of the track, near Hell's corner. It's close to Merchandise Alley, Food stalls, drink stalls and pit straight. It is a perfect location to be amongst the hustle and bustle, yet still immerse yourself in the Bathurst camping atmosphere. Toilets and Showers available on site.

Paddock Campground

Be right in the action, behind the pits in one of the most popular campgrounds, being the Paddock Campground. Easy walking distance to the Support category paddock and Supercars Paddock (**to which a Paddock Pass is required to access**), this campground provides some great behind the scenes action. Permanent toilets and showers available on site, accessible facilities included.

Chase Campground

Located outside the circuit near the Chase, the Chase Campground is perfect for easy camping and close to the action. Toilets and showers available on site.

The Orchard Campground

Located outside the circuit, this campground now has around 300 sites offering power (10amp single connection per site). The smaller powered sites are approximately 7 x7m with the larger sites being approximately 15x6m, perfect for Motorhomes. There are also approximately 300 NON-Powered sites also available in this campground. All sites are on Grass. The Orchard is perfect for easy camping with reasonably flat ground, toilets and showers available on site.

Motorhome Park

For those bringing Motorhomes or Caravans and want to still be in walking distance to the event, the Motorhome Campground is perfect for you. The Motorhome Park is located near the Enduro, The Orchard and The Chase campgrounds and Conrod Straight. The sites are **powered** and large enough to cater for Motorhome and Caravans with a single 15amp connection per site. Toilets and Showers available on site.

Enduro Campground

The Enduro campground is on the outside of the circuit, at the end of Conrod Straight which is the quickest part of the 6.2km Mount Panorama circuit. You'll be close to all the action, as well as being able to walk across the bridge and down to the Paddock area to see both the Support categories and the Supercars. Toilets and Showers available on site.

CHECKING IN AND DURATION OF STAY

When can I check-in to my campsite?

Once your campground opens, check-in is available between 7am – 10pm **daily** during the Booking Period.

How long do I have my campsite for?

You have access to your campsite for as long as the Booking Period specified in the table below. Campers must vacate their campsite by Closing time.

CAMPSITE CAPACITY AND DIMENSIONS

How many people can camp on my campsite?

A maximum of 8 people are allowed to camp on a campsite. A valid access wristband is required to enter the campgrounds. The wristbands are supplied once your valid entry ticket is scanned.

How big is my campsite?

The minimum approximate size of each campsite is listed below.

Please note: campsites are marked out by line markers each year and subject to minor changes in size and shape. Supercars makes no guarantee that the perimeters of your campsite will be straight or uniform in nature.

Can I use materials to cordon off my campsite?

Yes, provided such materials do not exceed 1.2m and remain within the perimeter of your campsite.

Can I bring a motorhome or caravan onto my site?

Yes, provided it fits within the perimeters of your campsite. Please note, not all sites are flat.

Is there overflow parking for additional vehicles?

Overflow parking is located at the foot of the Mountain (on Barry Gurdon Drive) or at the main public car parking area off Panorama Ave. Parking cannot be reserved at these lots and are on a first-come-first-served basis.

ACCESSING THE Paddock CAMPGROUND

What is the size of the access tunnel to the Paddock campground?

The access tunnel is 3.5 metres wide and 3.1 metres tall.

My vehicle won't fit in the tunnel. How can I access the Paddock campground?

You will need to access the campground via the racetrack outside of racing times. Racing times will be communicated closer to the start of the Event.

AMENITIES AND FACILITIES

Are there accessible amenities in campgrounds?

Accessible amenities are located in the permanent amenity blocks in the following campgrounds:

Reid and Sulman Campground

McPhillamy Campground

Paddock Campground

Where are the waste dump points?

The event precinct has on-site dump points at the following locations:

- The Paddock Campground
- Motorhome Campground
- The Chase Campground
- Reid & Sulman Campground

A new free dump point in Bathurst is also now available adjacent to the Waste Water Treatment Works, off the corner of Morrisset and Commonwealth Streets (205 Morrisset Street which is open 24/7).



The Bathurst dump point has water available for washing and is illuminated for night time use. There are CCTV cameras monitoring for any misuse or abuse.

The previous dump point is no longer available to the public.

ALCOHOL

How much alcohol can I bring onto the campground?

Each person can bring, and have in their possession, a maximum of ONE (1) type of the following alcohols on the campgrounds **per day (Maximum Quantities)**:

- a) one (1) x carton (30 x 375ml cans) of full-strength beer (5% alcohol or less); or
- b) one (1) x carton (30 x 375ml cans) of light / mid strength beer (3.5% alcohol or less); or
- c) one (1) x carton (24 x 375ml cans) of pre-mixed spirits (6% alcohol or less); or
- d) one (1) x carton (24 x 375ml cans) cider (5% alcohol or less); or
- e) one (1) x sealed 4 litre cask of wine (14.5% alcohol or less); or
- f) two (2) x 375ml unopened (manufacturer's seal unbroken) plastic bottles of spirits (38 % alcohol or less); or
- g) one (1) x 750ml bottle of spirits (**plastic bottle only**)

Supercars reserves the right to confiscate any alcohol found on the campgrounds to be in excess of the Maximum Quantities and will not be liable to you whatsoever for such confiscation. There is no storage or "check-in" facility for excess alcohol so please make yourself aware of these limits prior to attending the event.

CAMPFIRES

Can I have a fire in my campsite?

Fires are **only** permitted in campsites if:

- a) contained within a metal barrel, fire drum or equivalent vessel;
- b) the fire rating for the Central Ranges is not classified as Extreme or Catastrophic (as determined by the NSW Rural Fire Service); and
- c) any firewood used does not contain nails, bolts or screws.

Is firewood available to buy at the campgrounds?

Firewood can be ordered from Valley View Firewood for delivery to your site.

WEATHER

Can I get a refund for bad weather?

Supercars will only offer you a refund for bad weather if Supercars cancels or reschedules the Repco Bathurst 1000 as a result of such weather. Campers are advised to prepare for the likelihood of rain whilst staying within any campground on Mount Panorama, as it is likely to rain at some stage during their stay.

GENERAL

Can I bring glass into the campgrounds?

NO GLASS is to be brought into the campgrounds, other than glass jars 200mls or under in size containing spreads or food preserves.

Can I buy ice on the campgrounds?

Ice can be ordered from McFadden Ice Supplies for delivery to your site.

Can I bring my own food?

Yes.

There is also a range of food and beverage outlets throughout the Repco Bathurst 1000.

How much fuel can I take in for my generator?

A 20L drum of fuel for your personal generator is the maximum amount permitted to enter the event precinct per day.

Can I bring a BBQ to my campsite?

Yes, provided it remains on your campsite for the duration of your stay. Gas bottles must be no heavier than 9kg (inclusive of the weight of the gas) and must not be expired.

Can I bring my pet to the campgrounds?

Only assistance animals (as defined under the *Disability Discrimination Act 1992* (Cth)) will be permitted onto the campgrounds. No other pets are allowed on the campgrounds.

Can I bring fireworks into the event venue?

No fireworks or explosives of any kind may be brought into the Repco Bathurst 1000 event precinct, including the campgrounds.

Can I use materials to cordon off/reserve a viewing area in the campgrounds outside of my campsite?

No. Event staff may confiscate any such materials.

What furniture can I have on my campsite?

Temporary foldout chairs are permitted; however, no couches or lounge chairs are permitted into the campsite.

Is a shuttle bus service available?

There are several shuttle services available. Please refer to the "Getting There" section of the Event website www.supercars.com for details.
