### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS FOR SUPERCARS

#### CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

##### 1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- 1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “BEAUREPAIRES MELBOURNE SUPERSPRINT” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise of race 3, 4, 5 and 6 of the 2023 Repco Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at Albert Park Grand Prix Circuit, Melbourne, Victoria on 28<sup>th</sup> March – 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2023.

##### 1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

## 1.5 CIRCUIT DETAILS

- 1.5.1 **Track Length:** 5.303 kilometres
- 1.5.2 **Direction:** Clockwise
- 1.5.3 **Track Density:** Supercars – 32
- 1.5.4 **Stewards Office:** Located at the rear of the Supercars Garages.
- 1.5.5 **DRD Office:** Located at the rear of the Supercars Garages.
- 1.5.6 **Control Line:** Located at the Finish Line (and approximately ten (10) metres past the painted line) and across the Pit Entry.

## CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

### 2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2023 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **0900hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2023.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2023 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event Program.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1530hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2023 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

## CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

### **3.1 CONDITIONS OF THE EVENT (FORMULA 1 PRECEDENCE)**

- 3.1.1 The VCS is part of the Event hosting a round of the FIA Formula 1® World Championship 2023. Formula 1® activities will have priority over Supercars for the whole of the Event.
- 3.1.2 The Promoter reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Event or any part of it in accordance with NCR 11. In the case of abandonment or cancellation of the whole of the Event, entry fees will not be refunded by the Promoter.
- 3.1.3 The Organiser and Promoter will use reasonable endeavours to ensure that the Event is conducted as planned, however, the schedule of the Event may be varied at the Organiser's or the Promoter's absolute discretion.
- 3.1.4 Any variations that may occur to the Event schedule will be notified to Supercars as soon as practicable. Such variations will be considered final and will not be subject to protest.
- 3.1.5 Any Competitor, Driver or Team member who is not in the correct place at the required time may miss their participation in the Event.
- 3.1.6 Fines of no less than \$10,000 may be imposed on any Team or Driver which actively disrupts Formula 1 activities.

### **3.2 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK**

- 3.2.1 Each Team Transporter will require an accreditation Bump-in pass to access the Circuit and VCS Paddock. Teams must apply for this transporter bump in pass via the AGP accreditation portal.
- 3.2.2 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.2.3 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.2.4 NO vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time

### **3.3 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING**

- 3.3.1 Supercars accreditation is **NOT** recognised at this Event.
  - 3.3.1.1 Teams are to apply for promoter issued Accreditation through the AGPC Accreditation portal. The Supercars Accreditation Department will send instructions under separate cover.
  - 3.3.1.2 Promoter issued Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2023 to access the Event / Circuit.
- 3.3.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** The Promoter will issue Teams the following car park passes for the Event:
  - 3.3.2.1 1 Car Team – 2 x Motorsport Carpark and 3 x Competitor Carpark
  - 3.3.2.2 2 Car Team – 3 x Motorsport Carpark and 6 x Competitor Carpark
  - 3.3.2.3 4 Car Team – 6 x Motorsport Carpark and 12 x Competitor Carpark
  - 3.3.2.4 Cars with 'Motorsport' carpark passes must be parked in the 'M' Motorsport Car Park, located in the outfield at Turn 14, Driver's left. The cars with 'Competitor' car park passes must be parked in the Competitors Car Park, located adjacent to Lakeside Drive near Gate 10.
- 3.3.3 **VCS Golf Buggy Pass:** Each Team will be allocated one (1) Buggy pass with tunnel access.

### **3.4 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS**

3.4.1 The AGPC Accreditation Centre is located at Junction Oval, accessible via the Cricket Victoria entry gate, off Lakeside Drive. The entrance to the office is to the left of the Cricket Victoria reception counter.

3.4.2 The Accreditation Centre will be open at the following times **(AEDT)**:

### **3.5 RACE TRACK WALK**

3.5.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2023 only between **1600hrs** and **1830hrs (AEDT)**.

### **3.6 EVENT GATE ACCESS TIMES FOR TEAMS**

3.6.1 Promoter issued Accreditation as per Supplementary Regulation 3.3.1 will permit access to the Circuit and VCS Paddock through **Gate 10** from **0700hrs daily (AEDT)**:

3.6.2 Team personnel and/or guests in possession of Promoter issued General Admission (paper) tickets will not be permitted access to the venue until gates open to the public.

### **3.7 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT**

3.7.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

### **3.8 STORAGE**

3.8.1 Due to limited space in the Supercars paddock, no roll cabs or travel cases etc; are permitted to be stored in the Supercars Paddock.

### **3.9 DRIVER BATH WATER**

3.9.1 Team Driver Baths are only permitted to be located at the front Team Transporters.

3.9.2 Teams are to empty Driver baths at the front of Team transporters, no water or bath fluids are permitted to flow towards garages or into another Teams pack up areas.

## **CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**

### **4.1 MEDICAL SERVICES**

- 4.1.1 The Medical Centre is located on the road behind the VCS paddock and will be operational during the following times **(AEDT)**:
- 4.1.2 Operating Hours will be updated in *Further Supplementary Regulations*.

### **4.2 PIT GARAGE STRUCTURE**

- 4.2.1 Teams are not permitted to modify the bracing (if applicable) at the rear of the Pit Garage structure in anyway as it weakens the structure.
- 4.2.2 Teams are only permitted to use the 4 x 10amp power connections provided. Any connections to other sources will be cut off.

### **4.7 CARE FOR PARKLANDS**

- 4.7.1 Competitors are advised that the area used for the Event comprises public parkland for the remainder of the year and all Competitors, support personnel and any associated personnel shall comply with the Parks Victoria Site Induction Handbook which has been drawn up for the use of this area.
- 4.7.2 A current copy of the Parks Victoria Site Induction Handbook is attached to these regulations.
- 4.7.3 Teams are advised that the main points from the Site Induction Handbook include:
- 4.7.3.1 No trees may be pruned or damaged by users of the area - accidental damage must be reported to the National Race Paddock Manager as soon as possible.
- 4.7.3.2 The ground surface and grassed areas must not be damaged by users of the area - again, any damage must be reported to the National Race Paddock Manager.
- 4.7.3.3 No open fires may be lit at Albert Park.
- 4.7.3.4 All rubbish and refuse (including fuels and oils) shall be placed in suitable containers, or removed from Albert Park.
- 4.7.3.5 Any Team identified as dropping oil, fuels, or other contaminants on the ground or into the drainage system will be held responsible for any costs associated with decontamination of the area affected.
- 4.7.3.6 No rubbish or refuse shall be disposed of in such a manner as to allow it to end up in the drainage system or the lake.

- 4.7.3.7 All materials and equipment shall be stored so as to prevent damage to the site and minimise hazards to persons, materials, and equipment.
- 4.7.3.8 All users must comply with water restrictions in force in Melbourne if applicable. Statutory fines may apply if these are not followed.

#### **4.8 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES**

- 4.8.1 Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defuelling operation;
- 4.8.2 Motorsport Australia’s National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia’s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at motorsport.org.au.
- 4.8.3 Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
- 4.8.4 Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

## CHAPTER 5 -SPORTING

### 5.1 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

5.1.1 The Event operating hours (AEDT unless stated otherwise), for the purpose of **Rule E2.1.1** are as follows:

- 5.1.1.1 Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2023 0700 – 1840
- 5.1.1.2 Friday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023 0730 – end of VCS race 4
- 5.1.1.3 Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023 0730 – end of VCS race 5\*
- 5.1.1.4 Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2023 (**AEST**) 0730 – end of VCS race 6

5.1.2 Refer to Chapter 8. Event Program regarding **Rule E2.1.1.2**.

5.1.3 During all Formula 1® on track sessions, the front doors of each garage must be closed until the last Formula 1 car has received the chequered flag.

5.1.4 Team garages are required to be open with unbranded tensa barriers in position for the following Pit Lane walk sessions:

13:55 – 14:40
16:00 – 16:35
Friday 31 <sup>st</sup> March
11:10 – 12:00
Saturday 1 <sup>st</sup> April*
18:35 – 19:25

5.1.5 Pit Stop Practice is only permitted in accordance with the sessions highlighted in **Chapter 8 – Event Program**. Unbranded Tensa barriers to be in position as a crowd barrier.

### 5.2 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

5.2.1 In accordance with **Rule D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Melbourne:

### 5.3 BRIEFINGS

5.3.1 A briefing for all **Competitor’s Authorised Representatives & Drivers** will be held at **1530hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2023 in the Supercars Trackside Lounge, located above the Supercars Pit Garages.

### 5.4 PIT BAY MARKINGS

5.4.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:

- 5.4.1.1 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the left-hand side of the pit box, is required to be 4.0m and parallel from the edge of the Pit Building upright.
- 5.4.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.7m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.

## 5.5 EVENT RIDES AND TYRES

5.5.1 Teams undertaking Event rides are permitted to use an additional four (4) H or S, SS Control Tyres during the Event ride session only.

5.5.1.1 These tyres must be marked by Dunlop prior to the Event ride session.

5.5.1.2 These tyres are in addition to the Event tyre allocation.

## 5.6 Paddock Signage

5.6.1 The Promoter has granted permission for Teams to display flags on transporters, however, the Promoter may, at its discretion, request their removal at any time during the Event.

## 5.7 PIT LANE EQUIPMENT SIGNAGE

5.7.1 All Teams must either have removed or covered up all Pit Lane equipment signage at all times during the Event.

5.7.2 Teams will be permitted boom signage as follows:

5.7.3 A height of 300mm (H) maximum;

5.7.4 Only black or white is permitted as the background colour;

5.7.5 Only the car number is permitted to be displayed, in a colour of the Teams choice.

## 5.8 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS TYRE ALLOCATION

5.8.1 Teams must use the following tyre compounds during qualifying Sessions:

5.8.1.1 Qualifying race 3 – Hard (H) only

5.8.1.2 Qualifying race 4 – Super-Soft (SS) only

5.8.1.3 Qualifying race 5 - Hard (H) only

5.8.1.4 Qualifying race 6 - Super-Soft (SS) only

5.8.2 At this Event, Teams must use at least four (4) SS Tyres and at least four (4) H Tyres during race 3, 4, 5 and 6.

5.8.3 At this Event, **Rule D17.1.10** applies.

5.8.4 At this Event, the following new **Rule D17.7.11** will apply:

**D17.7.11** No later than thirty minutes (30) minutes prior to the 15-minute signal for race 3, 4, 5 & 6, Teams must nominate via email (motorsportoperations@supercars.com) the tyre compound they will commence that race with.

**D17.7.11.1** At the 15-minute signal for race 3, 4, 5 & 6, the tyre compound as nominated in **Rule D17.7.11** must be fitted to the Car and remain on the Car until the CPS window opens.

**D17.7.11.2** In the situation of **Rule D17.5.2** being declared for a race, Supplementary Regulation 5.8.1, 5.8.2, 5.8.3 and **Rule D17.7.11.1** will not apply to that race.

**D17.7.11.3** A Teams' non-compliance with **Rule D17.7.11** will be referred to the Stewards.

## 5.9 PRACTICE

5.9.1 At this Event, all practice Sessions will be time certain.

## 5.10 PRACTICE STARTS

5.10.1 Practice starts are **not** permitted at this Event.

## 5.11 GENERAL PRESCRIPTIONS – QUALIFYING

5.11.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D6.1.11.1**:

D6.1.11.1 At this Event, Teams are not permitted to refuel their Cars between qualifying race 3 and qualifying race 4 nor between qualifying race 5 and qualifying race 6.

## 5.12 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS QUALIFYING

5.12.1 At this Event, delete **Rule D6.1.3.2 a)** in its entirety and replace with the following:

D6.1.3.2 a) Each qualifying session will be time certain, except in extreme circumstances as determined by the Stewards, in which case the session may be extended.

## 5.13 PIT STOPS

5.13.1 For races **3, 4, 5** and **6** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:

5.13.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events**.

5.13.1.2 A Car may only perform a CPS after it commences lap 2 on the Race Track.

5.13.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.

5.13.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.

5.13.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 2 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 2, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

## 5.14 START PROCEDURE

5.14.1 The Start Procedure will be in accordance with **Rule D8.4 Specific Prescriptions – 15 minute Start Procedure**.

## 5.15 PIT CREW ACCESS ON GRID

5.15.1 Tyre equipment will be permitted in the Formula One Pit Lane, as advised over RMC.

5.15.2 During the Start Procedure, each Team will be permitted a maximum two (2) Team personnel for each Car.

## 5.16 SIGNALLING WALL

5.16.1 There is no provision for a signalling wall in the Supercars Pit lane, if Teams need to use a signalling wall during a Session they are permitted to do so from the Formula 1 Pit Lane signalling wall.

## 5.17 PERSONNEL

5.17.1 At this Event, note the following amendments to **Rule D24.3.1**:

D24.3.1 Unless otherwise advised in Supplementary Regulations, at each Event, save for an Endurance Event:

D24.3.1.1 Teams are permitted to have a maximum of ~~thirteen (13)~~ fourteen (14) Performance Personnel per two (2) Cars plus Driver/s.

D24.3.1.2 A single Car Team will be permitted to have a maximum of ~~nine (9)~~ ten (10) Performance Personnel for the Car plus Driver.

## 5.18 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

- 5.18.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.  
5.18.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

## CHAPTER 6 -TECHNICAL

### 6.1 ANTI-ROLL BARS

- 6.1.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule C7.6.2**:  
C7.6.2 The adjustment of the anti-roll bars ~~must only~~ is not permitted to be generated and controlled by the Driver, seated normally in the Car with their safety harness correctly fastened. Any adjustments conducted during a race are permitted via the use of hand tools only during a pit stop.

## CHAPTER 7 -MEDIA / MARKETING/ PROMOTIONAL

### 7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

- 7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.

### 7.2 GRID WALKS

- 7.2.1 At this Event, grid walks are **not** permitted.

### 7.3 ACCESS TO CORPORATE FACILITIES

- 7.3.1 Drivers and Team PR personnel that need to access the corporate facilities at this Event are to request the visitor access pass each suite has in their possession.

### 7.4 PROMOTIONAL STAFF

- 7.4.1 Promotional staff are not permitted within Albert Park (being the declared area and designated access areas as defined under the Australian Grands Prix Act 1994 (Vic)) by or on behalf of any of the Teams or their commercial partners at any time during the period of the Event without the prior written agreement of the Promoter.

### 7.5 MERCHANDISING

- 7.5.1 No goods or merchandise of any kind may be brought, sold, advertised, displayed, distributed or promoted within Albert Park (being the declared area and designated access areas as defined under the Australian Grands Prix Act 1994 (Vic)) by or on behalf of any of the Teams at any time during the period of the Event without the prior written agreement of the Promoter.
