SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS FOR SUPERCARS

CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “ITM AUCKLAND SUPERSPRINT” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise of race 27, 28 and 29 of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at Pukekohe Park Raceway, Pukekohe, New Zealand on 8th – 11th September 2022.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted International.

1.5 CIRCUIT DETAILS

- 1.5.1 **Track Length:** 2.91 kilometres
- 1.5.2 **Direction:** Clockwise
- 1.5.3 **Track Density:** Supercars – 40
- 1.5.4 **Notice Board:** Located at the base of the Timing building at the rear, next to the Race Control Tower.
- 1.5.5 **Stewards Office:** Located in a demountable building behind Race Control.
- 1.5.6 **DRD Office:** Located on the first floor of the Race Control Tower.
- 1.5.7 **Control Line:** Opposite the Race Control Tower across Pit Exit.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2022 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **1200hrs (NZDT)** on Thursday 8th September 2022.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2022 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event schedule.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1700hrs (NZDT)** on Thursday 8th September 2022 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

2.2 INDEMNITIES

- 2.2.1 Each Car's Competitor and Driver is required to complete and sign the Motorsport New Zealand Indemnity Form for this Event. This form must be completed and returned to Motorsport Operations prior to the commencement of the Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing on Thursday 8th September 2022. The Indemnity Form is included with these Supplementary Regulations.
- 2.2.2 For this Event, delete **Rule E6.5.1** and replace with the following:
E6.5.1 Prior to entering a Car, a passenger in a Ride, must have read and signed, or have had read to them and signed, an "**Event Rides Passenger Indemnity**".
- 2.2.3 For this Event, delete **Form F.17 Motorsport Australia Passenger Event Ride Entry Form** and replace with the Motorsport New Zealand (MSNZ) Passenger Ride Form. The MSNZ Form is attached with these Supplementary Regulations.

CHAPTER 3 -OPERATIONS

3.1 FLY-AWAY LOGISTICS TO NZ

- 3.1.1 Teams are required to follow the instructions and comply with the information emailed to all VCS Team Managers and Truck Drivers on Wednesday 27th June 2022 by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manger, Jason Routley.
- 3.1.2 Teams are not permitted to place or affix any signage of any kind, apart from the Supercars logo, on their air freight container. The only exception is a Team sticker on the front door of the container, no larger than 200mm x 150mm.

3.2 PROHIBITED ITEMS – CUSTOMS AND FREIGHT

- 3.2.1 The transportation of any food product to and from Australia by a Team is strictly prohibited.
- 3.2.2 Any wood product is not permitted to be transported to New Zealand unless the product has been previously approved for export by the Australian Quarantine and Inspection Service (AQIS) and the appropriate certification is supplied.
- 3.2.3 Teams are not permitted to transport fuel or empty fuel drums or containers to New Zealand for use at this Event. Teams' refuelling equipment is not considered a container for the application of this Supplementary Regulation.
- 3.2.4 Vehicle lithium batteries can travel connected inside the car.

3.3 ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK/ CONTAINER UNLOAD

- 3.3.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.3.2 Teams are permitted to commence unloading their containers from **0830hrs (NZDT)** on Thursday 8th September 2022 or at the direction of the Supercars Paddock Manager.
- 3.3.3 Due to WHS and the public accessing the paddock, VCS container unload must be completed by **1000hrs (NZDT)** on Friday 9th September 2022.
- 3.3.4 **NO** vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time.

3.4 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.4.1 Series hard- card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
- 3.4.1.1 Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Friday 9th September 2022 to access the Event / Circuit.
- 3.4.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each Car entry will be allocated three (3) car parking passes to park in the Teams car park (Car Park A).
- 3.4.2.1 Each 2-Car Team will be allocated one (1) transit car pass and will be permitted to enter the paddock for the sole purpose of delivering supplies. All deliveries must take place outside of Event Operating Hours as per Supplementary Regulation 5.1.
- 3.4.3 **Grid Walk Pass collection** – To be collected from the Accreditation Centre.

3.5 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.5.1 The Accreditation Centre is located at **Gate 1A**.
- 3.5.2 The Accreditation Centre will be open as per below **(NZDT)**:

- 3.5.3 During the Event, all tickets/ passes that require collection by public/ Team guests must be left at the Ticketek Box Office located at **Gate 1A** (in an envelope with the collector's name). The Box Office will be open approx. 30min ahead of gates opening on Friday – Sunday.

3.6 TYRE TENT / CATERING TENT SETUP

- 3.6.1 Tyre tents are not permitted on the concrete patch at the rear of the garages. Tyre tents are only permitted on the grass mound at the rear of the garages (Horse track).
- 3.6.2 In accordance with **Rule E2.1.4:**
- 3.6.2.1 Teams will only be permitted one (1) 6m x 3m tyre tent or one (1) 5m x 5m tyre tent per transporter that is usually at an Event.
- 3.6.2.2 Each two-car Team will only be permitted one (1) 6m x 3m structure for the purpose of operating Team catering.

3.7 RACE TRACK WALK

- 3.7.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Thursday 8th September 2022 between **1500hrs** and **1700hrs (NZDT)**.

3.8 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.8.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.
- 3.8.2 At the conclusion of race 29, Teams are required to have staff available at the Dunlop Tyre Fitting facility to strip, clean and bag their wheels for return freight to Australia. It will be the responsibility of each Team to ensure the bagged wheels are loaded into the designated air freight containers as directed by Gibson Freight.
- 3.8.3 All fuel vessels are to be completely cleaned and emptied.
- 3.8.4 Splitter bags (front and rear) must only contain splitters. **No** spare parts or consumables are permitted to be packed.
- 3.8.5 Supercars master locks must be used on containers while in transit. **No** Teams locks are permitted to be used under any circumstances.

CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.1 COVID-19 RESPONSE

- 4.1.1 This Event will be in accordance with the New Zealand Ministry of Health COVID-19 Health Orders.
- 4.1.2 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule E3.2.1**:
E3.2.1 Additional Event specific COVID-19 management protocols will be specified in the ~~Event Supplementary Regulations~~ by the Promoter.
- 4.1.3 Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend their place of work, travel interstate or attend the event.
- 4.1.4 Each Team is to appoint a COVID-19 Compliance Officer to manage their Teams compliance with COVID-19 regulations and health requirements.

- 4.7.2 Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a MotorSport New Zealand accredited testing Official in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

5.1 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

5.3 BRIEFINGS

5.3.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1700hrs (NZDT)** on Thursday 8th September 2022 in the Supercars Paddock Club, located halfway along the Pit Roof.

5.3.2 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers** will be held at **1715hrs (NZDT)** on Friday 9th September 2022 in the Supercars Paddock Club, located halfway along the Pit Roof.

5.4 PIT BAY MARKINGS

5.4.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:

- 5.4.1.1 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the left-hand side of the pit box, is required to be 4.0m and parallel from the edge of the Pit Building upright.
- 5.4.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.7m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.

5.5 PIT STOPS

5.5.1 For races **27, 28** and **29** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:

- 5.5.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events**.
- 5.5.1.2 A Car may only perform a CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.
- 5.5.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
- 5.5.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
- 5.5.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

5.6 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

5.6.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.

- 5.6.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

5.7 IN-CAR CAMERA

- 5.7.1 At this Event, Cars are required to have a dummy roof camera fitted, which complies with **Rule C4.1** and **Rule C4.2**.
- 5.7.1.1 There is no requirement for a Car to be fitted with a dummy boot camera or boot camera ballast.
