CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the "PERTH SUPERSPRINT" (hereinafter referred to as "the Event"), which will also comprise of race 7, 8 and 9 of the 2023 Repco Supercars Championship ("the VCS"), and be held at Wanneroo Raceway, Wanneroo, Perth on 27th – 30th April 2023.

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual ("the Rules"), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2023 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **0900hrs (AWST)** on Thursday 27th April 2023.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2023 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event Program.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1700hrs (AWST)** on Thursday 27th April 2023 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.







CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

3.1 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.1.3 Transporters must not enter the Supercars Paddock prior to **0830hrs (AWST)** on Thursday 27th April 2023 and all movements must be with the prior approval of the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.4 Transporter unload will commence when the final Supercars Transporter is in position.
- 3.1.5 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock at any time.
- 3.1.6 **NO** vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time

3.2 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 Series hard- card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
 - 3.2.1.1 Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Friday 28th April 2023 to access the Event / Circuit.
- 3.2.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each Car will be allocated three (3) x car passes for Car Park B on the outside of the Circuit.
 - 3.2.2.1 Each VCS Team will receive one (1) Transit Pass for the purpose of delivering catering supplies to the Team garage. Deliveries are required to take place outside of Event Operating Hours. Under no circumstances are vehicles to be parked anywhere other than outside the venue once the delivery is completed.
- 3.2.3 Grid Walk Pass collection: Passes must be collected at the Accreditation Centre (They are not to be collected at the Supercars Ops Truck).

3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.3.1 The Accreditation Centre is located at the **Mega Fast Karts carpark** (Wanneroo International Kartway, 1 Wattle Ave E, Neerabup WA 6031).
- 3.3.2 The Accreditation Centre will be open at the following times (AWST):

3.4 EVENT GATE ACCESS TIMES FOR TEAMS

3.4.1 Teams are required to access the precinct via **Gate 1** (Wattle Ave East).

3.5 RACE TRACK WALK

3.5.1 Teams are only permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Thursday 27th April 2023 between **1330hrs** and **1600hrs (AWST)**.







3.6 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

3.6.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

3.7 GOLF BUGGIES

3.7.1 All Golf Buggies must be road registered.

3.8 DRIVER BATH WATER

3.8.1 Teams are to empty Driver baths at the front of Team transporters, no water or bath fluids are permitted to flow towards garages or into another Teams pack up areas.







CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.1 MEDICAL SERVICES

4.1.1 The Medical Receiving Centre for on track activities is located in the infield Medical Centre situated near Pit Entry and will be operational during the following times (AWST):

4.2 PADDOCK WHS

- 4.2.1 Neither fuel or tyres are permitted to be carried across the pedestrian bridge.
- 4.2.2 The pedestrian bridge will be closed for all race starts.
- 4.2.3 Only oil can be placed in the waste oil drums at the Raceway. Oil filters, coolant, brake and power steering fluids must be disposed of at the competitor's cost at a government approved collection centre. For further information see www.oilrecycling.gov.au.

4.7 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

- 4.7.1 Wanneroo Raceway is a smoke and vape free venue. Patrons must exit the venue should they wish to smoke or vape.
- 4.7.2 Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defuelling operation;







- 4.7.3 Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at motorsport.org.au.
- 4.7.4 Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
- 4.7.5 Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

CHAPTER 5 - SPORTING

5.1 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

5.1.1 The Event operating hours **(AWST)**, for the purpose of **Rule E2.1.1** are as follows:

5.1.1.1 Friday 28th April 2023 0830 – 1600

5.1.1.2 Saturday 29th April 2023 0810 – end of VCS race 7

5.1.1.3 Sunday 30th April 2023 (**AEST**) 0710 – end of VCS race 9

5.1.2 Refer to Chapter 8. Event Program regarding **Rule E2.1.2.1**.

5.2 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

5.2.1 In accordance with Rule **D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Joondalup: http://www.bom.gov.au/places/wa/joondalup/forecast/

5.3 BRIEFINGS

- 5.3.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1700hrs** (AWST) on Thursday 27th April 2023 in the Supercars Paddock Club, located via the Pedestrian Bridge and turning right to the Corporate facilities.
- 5.3.2 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers** will be held at **1745hrs (AWST)** on Friday 28th April 2023 in the Supercars Paddock Club, located via the Pedestrian Bridge and turning right to the Corporate facilities.

5.4 PIT BAY MARKINGS

- 5.4.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:
 - 5.4.1.1 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the left-hand side of the pit box, is required to be 4.0m and parallel from the edge of the Pit Building upright.
 - 5.4.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.4m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.

5.5 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – VCS QUALIFYING

5.5.1 At this Event, for qualifying race 7 only, note the following amendments to **Rule D6.2.3.1**:

D6.2.3.1 This Session will commence as per the following:







- a) Qualifying Part 1 (Q1): During the first <u>fifteen</u> (<u>15</u>) minutes of the Session all Cars take part. At the end of Q1, the twenty (20) fastest Cars in order will be permitted to continue to Q2. The remaining Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times of the twenty (20) fastest Cars will then be deleted.
- <u>b)</u> Qualifying Part 2 (Q2): After a five (5) minute break the Session will resume for <u>fifteen</u> (<u>15</u>) minutes and only the remaining Cars from Q1 will be permitted to take part. At the end of Q2, the ten (10) fastest Cars in order will be permitted to continue in the Session. The lap times achieved by the ten (10) fastest Cars will then be deleted.
- Qualifying Part 3 (Q3): After a five (5) minute break the Session will resume for <u>fifteen</u> (<u>15</u>) minutes and only the top ten (10) Cars from Q2 will be permitted to take part.

5.6 PIT STOPS

- 5.6.1 For races **7**, **8**, and **9** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
 - 5.6.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events**.
 - 5.6.1.2 A Car may only perform a CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.
 - 5.6.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
 - 5.6.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
 - 5.6.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

5.7 PERSONNEL

- 5.7.1 At this Event, note the following amendments to **Rule D24.3.1**:
 - <u>D24.3.1</u> Unless otherwise advised in Supplementary Regulations, at each Event, save for an Endurance Event:
 - <u>D24.3.1.1</u> Teams are permitted to have a maximum of thirteen (13) fourteen (14) Performance Personnel per two (2) Cars plus Driver/s.
 - <u>D24.3.1.2</u> A single Car Team will be permitted to have a maximum of nine (9) ten (10) Performance Personnel for the Car plus Driver.

5.8 PENALTIES FOR KERB INFRINGEMENTS

- 5.8.1 At this Event, in respect to turn 7 only, delete **Rule B7.6.1.1** and replace with the following:

 B7.6.1.1 During any practice and qualifying session:
 - a) That lap time and the subsequent lap time will be disallowed.

5.9 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

- 5.9.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.
 - 5.9.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.
