CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the "VODAFONE GOLD COAST 600" (hereinafter referred to as "the Event"), which will also comprise race 26 and 27 of the 2019 International Virgin Australia Supercars Championship ("the VCS"), and be held at the Surfers Paradise Street Circuit, Gold Coast, QLD on 23rd October – 27th October 2019.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual ("the Rules"), and any applicable National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **0900hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 24th October 2019.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2019 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing as detailed in the Event schedule.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1700hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 24th October 2019 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.
- 2.1.5 Any Competitor that has cross entered Drivers, must nominate their final Car Driver pairing prior to 1700hrs (AEST) on Friday 25th October 2019.

2.3 PRESENTATION OF A CAR

A4.3.3.1

2.3.1 Delete **Rule A4.3.3.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

I being the Authorised Representative of the Car described on the Supercars Entry Registration Form and legally authorised to enter the Car described on this form, hereby declare and undertake to Supercars Australia and the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS) that the Car and all related equipment and components necessary for participation in this Event shall be presented, at all times and in every respect, in a condition suitable for use in this activity, and that I have caused the Car to be inspected according to a maintenance schedule which I have developed and that it is free from mechanical defects, be they of preparation or structural integrity, that may render the Car unsafe for the proposed activity.

Further, I acknowledge and agree that where any aspect of the Car or related equipment and components is found:

- to be in breach of the Rules and/or the Regulations of the Event, or;
- in the opinion of the Sporting & Technical Director <u>Head of Motorsport</u>, to be subject to a serious mechanical defect, it will render me in breach of the Rules, and that I may be subject to penalties in accordance with the Rules.

2.4 HEARINGS

2.4.1 Delete **Rule B3.11.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

<u>B3.11.1</u> After the Hearing has concluded, the Stewards notify the persons and parties concerned of their decision on the matter consistent with the information available at the Hearing, and subject to Rule <u>B8.2 B7.2</u> impose such Penalties and make such orders and give such directions as they may think fit.

CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS

3.1 ACCESS TO PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Details of Transporter access into the Circuit and set up of the Supercars paddock, will be as per the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.







3.2 ACCREDITATION CARDS (PASSES) & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 The Series Accreditation Cards will be recognised by the Organisers.
- 3.2.2 Accreditation will be required from Thursday 24th October 2019.
- 3.2.3 Each entry will be allocated one (1) VIP car pass to park in the Commodore Drive car park in Paradise Waters.
- 3.2.4 Each Team caterer will be allocated one (1) transit car pass and will be permitted to enter the paddock for the sole purpose of delivering supplies.
 - 3.2.4.1 All deliveries must be completed between the hours of **1900hrs 0700hrs** (AEST) from Friday 25th October through to Sunday 27th October 2019.
 - 3.2.4.2 Caterers with a transit car pass must park at the Commodore Park car park located at Paradise Waters and as such will be allocated a VIP car pass that will need to be displayed.
 - 3.2.4.3 Vehicles located in the paddock outside the restricted delivery hours detailed in 3.2.4.1 will be towed.

3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.3.1 The Accreditation centre is located at Gate One (1) in the Accreditation demountable on the corner of Tedder and Breaker Streets in Main Beach.

- 3.5.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Thursday 24th October 2019 between **1430hrs** and **1630hrs (AEST)**.
- 3.5.2 The Race Track will still be used by working vehicles and machinery during the Race Track Walk. As such, keep to one side of the Race Track where possible and be aware of your surroundings.

3.6 PORTABLE BUILDINGS

3.6.1 Teams must provide their own padlock/s for their allocated portable building/s.

3.7 TRANSPORTER DEPARTURE AFTER THE EVENT

3.7.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be as per the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.







CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

4.6 GOLF BUGGIES

4.6.1 Golf buggies are not permitted at this Event.

4.7 DELIVERIES AND ACCESS BY NON-ENDORSED EVENT SUPPLIERS

4.7.1 It is the Team's responsibility to ensure any service providers/contractors they engage who are not an endorsed supplier, have the correct accreditation to access the venue and any applicable site safety induction is completed.

4.8 CARE FOR PARKLANDS

4.8.1 Competitors must be aware that Macintosh Island is a valuable asset to the host community, so all Teams are required to treat the areas available within the Parklands with respect and discretion to minimise any adverse environmental impact.

4.9 HEALTH AND SAFETY

4.9.1 In accordance with the Queensland Health and Safety Act, smoking is only permitted within a Nominated Outdoor Smoking Place (NOSP) for the duration of the Event. Queensland Health Officers will be onsite during the Event.







4.10 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAV) PROHIBITION

- 4.10.1 Be advised that the use (operation) of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), drones, or other similar devices, by any Competitor, Team, Team member or person/s associated with a Team or Competitor is prohibited.
- 4.10.2 This prohibition extends for the period of the Event defined as the Event period over the Event area defined as the Event area.
- 4.10.3 It also includes the prohibition of the use (operation) of any unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), drone or similar device from outside the declared area of the Event over the declared area during the Event period.
- 4.10.4 A breach of this prohibition will result in disqualification from the Event for any offending Competitor and or Team and Driver/s. All credentials or admission tickets issued to any offending Competitor or Team, and associated personnel will also be withdrawn.
- 4.10.5 The prohibition and Penalty for a breach of same as outlined above, is in addition to any Penalty/Penalties that may occur as a result of breaching Civil Aviation Authority (CASA) regulations in relation to the use of UAVs in controlled airspace, and over areas containing significant numbers of people.

CHAPTER 5 - SPORTING

5.1 TYRE FITTING, ALLOCATION AND USAGE

- 5.1.1 Control tyre fitting will commence from **0900hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 24th October 2019 in the Dunlop garages located in the Supercars paddock.
- 5.1.2 The Dunlop tyre fitting hours of operation are as follows:

5.1.2.1 Friday 25th October 0800 – 1800 5.1.2.2 Saturday 26th October 0730 – 1800

5.1.2.3 Sunday 27th October 0730 – end of VCS race 27

5.2 MARKINGS ON CARS

5.2.1 Delete **Rule E1.6.2.3** in its entirety and replace with the following:

E1.6.2.3 The surnames of each Driver must be:

a) Height: Sprint Events & DS2 Rounds: 400 80mm

Endurance Events: 50 35mm

b) Font: Sprint Events & DS2 Rounds: Helvetica Bold Condensed

Endurance Events: Helvetica Bold Condensed

Position: Lower edge of each rear door window.

5.2.2 Delete **reference 2, 4 and 8**. in **Schedule E1 Markings on Cars** in its entirety and replace with the below:

5.3 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PITS AND PADDOCK

5.3.1 Update Rule **E3.2.7** with the below additional Rule:

<u>E3.2.7.4</u> All gas cylinders must be secured and have the main valve in the fully off position during all movements at an Event.

5.4 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

5.4.1 The Event operating hours (AEST) for the purpose of Rule E2 are as follows:

5.4.1.1 Friday 25th October 0800 – 1715

5.4.1.2 Saturday 26th October 0735 – after VCS Race 26 5.4.1.3 Sunday 27th October 0715 – after VCS Race 27

5.5 BRIEFINGS

- 5.5.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1700hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 24th October 2019 in the Press Conference Room, located on the First Floor Media Centre. Entry Via the Northern Staircase for direct access to the Briefing Room.
- 5.5.2 A briefing for all **Competitors and Drivers** will be held at **1750hrs (AEST)** on Friday 25th October 2019 in the Press Conference Room, located on the First Floor Media Centre. Entry Via the Northern Staircase for direct access to the Briefing Room.

5.6 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

5.6.1 In accordance with Rule **D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Surfers Paradise. http://www.bom.gov.au./places/qld/surfers-paradise/

5.7 PRACTICE

- 5.7.1 All Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 1 and 3.
- 5.7.2 Only additional Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 2.

5.8 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – START PROCEDURE

5.8.1 For this Event, for race 26 and 27 update the following **Rules: D8.3.1, D8.3.1.1, D8.3.2.1, D8.3.2.4, D8.3.3** and **D8.3.3.1**:

D8.3.1 Thirty Forty Minutes:

<u>D8.3.1.1</u> When <u>30 40</u> minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

D8.3.2 Twenty-Five Thirty-Five Minutes:

<u>D8.3.2.1</u> When <u>25 35</u> minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

<u>D8.3.2.4.1</u> Team trolleys are required to be positioned directly behind the rear of the Car and perpendicular to the track direction.

<u>D8.3.2.4.2</u> Teams are not permitted to use a fan of any type, with the exception of Driver cooling.

D8.3.3 Fifteen Twenty-Five minutes:

<u>D8.3.3.1</u> When <u>15 25</u> minutes remain before the formation lap, a warning will be sounded.

5.9 SAFETY CAR PROCEDURE

5.9.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D10.2.13** in its entirety and replace with the following:

<u>D10.2.13</u> Prior to the lead Car crossing the Control Line at the end of a SC deployment, or on the restart lap, any Car that is two (2) or more laps behind the lead Car







must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is less than two (2) laps behind the lead Car.

Should a SC deployment end eight (8) laps or less from the last lap of a race, or ten (10) minutes prior to the time certain finish time of a race as published in the Supplementary Regulations, any Car that is one (1) or more laps behind the leader must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is on the lead lap.

5.10 AIR IMPACT TOOLS AND PRESSURE VESSELS

- 5.10.1 At this Event, delete **Rule D11.3.2** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - <u>D11.3.2</u> A Team must be equipped with a minimum of four (4) air impact tools and an air lance during any race.
 - <u>Pressure Sensors are not permitted to be affixed to any air line connected to an air impact tool or air lance.</u>

5.11 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS - PIT LANE

- 5.11.1 Delete **Rule D11.5.2.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - <u>D11.5.2.1</u> Only Officials, Team members in accordance with Rule <u>D8.1.8</u> <u>D8.1.6</u> and media personnel specifically authorised by the RD, are permitted at the Pit signalling wall from the time that the Cars move off on the formation lap.

5.12 PIT BAY MARKING

- 5.12.1 For this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be located in the following position
 - 5.12.1.1 The outside edge of the race tape marking the right-hand side line of the pit box is not permitted to be greater than 5m from the edge of the Pit Building upright.

5.13 USE OF EQUIPMENT / TOOLS

- 5.13.1 At this Event, update **Rule D11.7** with the following:
 - <u>D11.7.11</u> <u>Teams are not permitted to use a data logger affixed on any pitlane equipment.</u>

5.14 PIT STOPS - DRIVER CHANGE

5.14.1 When stopping to change Drivers and when the Car is in the Pit Lane (40km/h section), the Driver may only loosen the shoulder straps provided they remain substantially in place over the shoulders.

5.15 PERSONNEL

- 5.15.1 For this Event, update **Rule D11.2.4** as per below:
 - **D11.2.4** Refueler / Vent Attendant
 - D11.2.4.1 Whose sole task is to hold, operate and control the Refuelling/vent hose in accordance with Rule D25.6.2.
 - <u>Permitted to assist with servicing of the Car during Pit Stops</u> where no refuelling is conducted.
- 5.15.2 For this Event update **Rule D11.2.6** as per below:
 - **D11.2.6** Fire Attendant
 - **D11.2.6.1** Whose sole task is to operate the fire extinguisher in accordance with **Rule D25.6.2**.







<u>Permitted to assist with servicing of the Car during Pit Stops</u> where no refuelling is conducted.

5.16 PIT STOPS

- 5.16.1 For race 26 and 27, the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
 - 5.16.1.1 Each Car must complete <u>the</u> one (1) CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2**. **Format of VCS Events**.
 - 5.16.1.2 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
 - 5.16.1.3 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
- 5.16.2 For this Event, delete Rule **D11.8.8** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - During any Pit Stop, from the time the Car leaves the ground until the time the Car has returned to the ground, the brake lock mechanism must be engaged so as the rear wheels do not rotate without the prior approval of the HoM.
 - <u>D11.8.8.1</u> Where the HoM grants such approval, the <u>rear</u> wheels must stop rotating prior to the Car being lowered to the ground. For the sake of clarity, the <u>rear</u> wheels must not be rotating while the Car is being lowered to the ground.
 - <u>During any Pit Stop</u>, a slight movement of the rear wheels will not, at the sole discretion of the HoM, constitute the rear wheels rotating.

5.17 PARC FERMÉ

- 5.17.1 At this Event, update Rule **D13.5.1** as follows:
 - <u>D13.5.1</u> Unless otherwise authorised by the HoM, Teams are only permitted to undertake the following while any Car is in Parc Fermé:
 - <u>D13.5.1.1</u> Check Control Tyres pressures;
 - D13.5.1.2 Loosen the wheels;
 - D13.5.1.3 Rotate the wheels;
 - <u>D13.5.1.4</u> Install cool suit loop lines and remove dry ice;
 - <u>D13.5.1.5</u> Position cooling fans in the radiator and/or brake duct in takes in the front bumper bar;
 - <u>D13.5.1.6</u> Connect auxiliary power pack;
 - <u>D13.5.1.7</u> One crew member is permitted to download the Data Logger;
 - <u>Within 20 minutes of the Session being complete, data from the fastest lap and the last outing from the Session must be uploaded to a network location specified by the MOM.</u>
 - a. For any VCS race, all data from the Session must be supplied;
 - b. For the final VCS race of the Event, data must be supplied to the Supercars Motorsport Department on the provided USB storage device within 20 minutes of the session being complete.

5.18 POINT SCORE

- 5.18.1 Delete **Rule D14.1.5** in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - <u>D14.1.5</u> Each Driver will be awarded points based on the Final <u>Classification</u> of each race in the VCS and the DS2, subject to any Penalties imposed.





5.19 CONTROL TYRES

5.19.1 Delete **Rule D17.1.15** in its entirety and replace with the following:

It is not permitted for a Team to seek, order or accept the direct supply of any H, S or SS Control Tyres from Dunlop.

5.20 FRONT BRAKE ROTORS

- 5.20.1 Only marked sets of front discs are permitted at this Event.
- 5.20.2 All marked front discs count towards Rule D19.1.

5.21 FUEL RIGS

5.21.1 Fuel rigs are not permitted to be stored in pit lane, spare garages or breezeways.

CHAPTER 6 - TECHNICAL

6.1 SCRUTINEERING

6.1.1 Scrutineering will commence at **0730hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 24th October 2019.

6.2 REAR VISION MIRRORS

6.2.1 Delete **Rule C6.5.2** and replace with the following:

C6.5.2 A Car must be fitted with both a left and right-hand side external rear vision mirror. If the left-hand side external rear vision mirror is removed, the opening must be covered. The use of "race tape" to cover the opening is permitted.

CHAPTER 7 -MARKETING

7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.

7.2 GRID WALK

- 7.2.1 Where permitted, movement of non-Team members on and off the grid must only be via the point/s as described in the Competitor's Authorised Representative Briefing.
- 7.2.2 Promotional staff, Drivers and those listed on the **D23** personnel list are the only people permitted on the grid in addition to those that are wearing a grid walk access wristband.







CHAPTER 8 - EVENT PROGRAM

8.1 STADIUM SUPER TRUCKS

8.1.1 During all Stadium Super Truck demonstrations listed in the Event Program, no personnel are permitted to be on the signalling wall or in the fast lane.
