CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the "Tyrepower Tasmania SuperSprint" (hereinafter referred to as "the Event") which will also comprise races 7 and 8 of the 2018 Virgin Australia Supercars Championship ("the VCS"), and be held at Symmons Plains Raceway. Symmons Plains. Tasmania on 6th – 8th April 2018.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual ("the Rules"), and any applicable National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

1.5.1 Track Length: 2.4 kilometres
1.5.2 Direction: Anti-Clockwise
1.5.3 Track Density: Supercars – 32

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2018 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **1200hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 4th April 2018.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitor that needs to change or add any details contained in their 2018 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** on Thursday 5th April 2018.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1630hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 5th April 2018 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

2.2 ACCREDITATION CARDS (PASSES) & TEAM PARKING

- 2.2.1 The Series Accreditation Cards will be recognised by the Organisers.
- 2.2.2 Accreditation will be required from Friday 6th April 2018.
- 2.2.3 Each entry will be allocated 3 x passes for the Teams' Car Park, and 1 x pass for the VIP Car Park.







2.2.4 Each Team caterer will be allocated 1 x transit pass and will be permitted to enter the Supercars Paddock only for the purpose of delivering supplies. These cars must not park in the paddock, but in the Teams' Car Park.

CHAPTER 3 - TECHNICAL

3.1.1 Scrutineering will commence at **0830hrs** on Friday 6th April 2018.

CHAPTER 4 - SPORTING

4.1 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

4.2 BRIEFINGS

- 4.2.1 A briefing for **all Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1630hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 5th April 2018 in Supercars Paddock Club located above the Pit Lane Garages
- 4.2.2 A briefing for **all Competitors and Drivers** will be held at **1730hrs (AEST)** on Friday 6th April 2018 in the Supercars Paddock Club located above the Pit Lane Garages

4.3 TYRE FITTING, ALLOCATION AND USAGE

4.3.1 Control Tyre fitting will commence from **0900hrs** on Thursday 5th April 2018 in the Dunlop facility located in the Supercars paddock.

4.4 QUALIFYING

- 4.4.1 In addition to the requirements of Rule D6, qualifying for each race will be conducted in accordance with this Supplementary Regulation and as prescribed in the Event Program.
- 4.4.2 Qualifying Race 7:
 - 4.4.2.1 Qualifying Part 1 (Q1): During the first ten (10) minutes of the Session only the bottom sixteen (16) Cars in order of the final combined classification from practice 1 and 2 will be permitted to Compete. At the end of Q1, the slowest ten (10) Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times achieved by the six (6) remaining Cars will then be deleted.
 - 4.4.2.2 Qualifying Part 2 (Q2): After a five (5) minute break the Session will resume for Ten (10) minutes and only the top ten (10) Cars in order of the final combined classification from practice 1 and 2 and the top six (6) Cars from Q1 will be permitted to Compete. At the end of Q2, the slowest six (6) Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times achieved by the ten (10) remaining Cars will then be deleted.
 - 4.4.2.3 Qualifying Part 3 (Q3): After a five (5) minute break the Session will resume for Ten (10) minutes and only the top ten (10) Cars from Q2 will be permitted to Compete.







4.4.3 Qualifying - Race 8:

- 4.4.3.1 Qualifying Part 1 (Q1): During the first ten (10) minutes of the Session only the bottom sixteen (16) Cars in order of the final classification from practice 4 will be permitted to Compete. At the end of Q1, the slowest ten (10) Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times achieved by the six (6) remaining Cars will then be deleted.
- 4.4.3.2 Qualifying Part 2 (Q2): After a five (5) minute break the Session will resume for Ten (10) minutes and only the top ten (10) Cars in order of the final classification from practice 4 and the top six (6) Cars from Q1 will be permitted to Compete. At the end of Q2, the slowest six (6) Cars will not be permitted to take any further part in the Session. The lap times achieved by the ten (10) remaining Cars will then be deleted.
- 4.4.3.3 Qualifying Part 3 (Q3): After a five (5) minute break the Session will resume for Ten (10) minutes and only the top ten (10) Cars from Q2 will be permitted to Compete.

4.5 GRID DETERMINATION

- 4.5.1 Grid positions will be determined by the final classification of qualifying and as follows:
 - 4.5.1.1 The last ten (10) grid positions will be occupied by the Cars eliminated in Q1 with the fastest Car in 17th position.
 - 4.5.1.2 The next six (6) grid positions will be occupied by the Cars eliminated in Q2 with the fastest Car in 11th position.
 - 4.5.1.3 The top ten (10) grid positions will be occupied by the Cars, which Competed in Q3 with the fastest Car in 1st position.
- 4.5.2 Cars that are disqualified from the qualifying Session will start at the rear of the grid in order of the final combined classification of practice from fastest Driver to slowest Driver.

4.6 COMPULSORY PIT STOPS

- 4.6.1 For race 7 only, the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
 - 4.6.1.1 Each Car must complete one (1) CPS.
 - 4.6.1.2 A Car may only complete its CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.
 - 4.6.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
 - 4.6.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
 - 4.6.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.



CHAPTER 5 - OPERATIONS



5.1 ACCESS TO PADDOCK

- 5.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars.
- 5.1.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Coordinator. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 5.1.3 Transporters are permitted to enter the Supercars paddock and park up on arrival from the Wharf on Wednesday 4th April 2018.
- 5.1.4 Other than Team caterers who have the required Transit Car Pass, Passenger vehicles are not permitted to enter the Supercars paddock from **0800hrs** on Thursday 5th April 2018.

5.2 RACE TRACK WALK

- 5.2.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk between **1300hrs** and **1600hrs** on Thursday 5th April 2018.
- 5.2.2 The Race Track will still be used by working vehicles and machinery during the Race Track Walk. As such, keep to one side of the Race Track where possible and be aware of your surroundings.

5.3 STORAGE

- 5.3.1 Fuel drums are not permitted to be stored directly next to each other.
- 5.3.2 It is not permitted to store anything under the stairs that lead up to the corporate facilities above the Pit Lane.

5.4 TRANSPORTER DEPARTURE AFTER THE EVENT

5.4.1 Unless otherwise advised by Supercars, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock prior to **1800** (AEST) hours on Sunday 8th April 2018.

CHAPTER 6 - MARKETING

6.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

6.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by Supercars.

6.2 GRID WALK

- 6.2.1 Where permitted, movement of non-Team members on and off the grid must only be via the point/s as described in the Competitor's Authorised Representative Briefing.
- 6.2.2 Promotional staff, Drivers and those listed on the **D23** personnel list are the only people permitted on the grid in addition to those that are wearing a grid sticker.







6.3 TRANSPORTER PARADE

- 6.3.1 The transporter parade will be held on Wednesday 4 April 2018.
- 6.3.2 The transporter parade schedule will be as follows:
 - 6.3.2.1 **1445hrs**: All vehicle and transporter operators to be ready for a driver briefing, to be held at the rear of the control tower at Symmons Plains.
 - 6.3.2.2 **1500hrs:** Convoy to depart from Symmons Plains accompanied by police escort.
 - 6.3.2.3 **1605hrs:** Approximate turn-around at George Town for return to Symmons Plains. Park up to commence immediately upon return, approximately **1645hrs**.

CHAPTER 7 - SPECIFIC CIRCUIT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

7.1 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

7.6 HEALTH AND SAFETY

7.6.1 In line with the Tasmanian Health and Safety Act, the Supercars Paddock will be a smoke-free zone for the duration of the Event.

7.7 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAV) PROHIBITION

- 7.7.1 Be advised that the use (operation) of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), drones, or other similar devices, by any Competitor, Team, Team member or person/s associated with a Team or Competitor is prohibited.
- 7.7.2 This prohibition extends for the period of the Event defined as the Event period over the Event area defined as the Event area.
- 7.7.3 It also includes the prohibition of the use (operation) of any unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), drone or similar device from outside the declared area of the Event over the declared area during the Event period.
- 7.7.4 A breach of this prohibition will result in the exclusion from the Event for any offending Competitor and or Team and Driver/s. All credentials or admission tickets issued to any offending Competitor or Team, and associated personnel will also be withdrawn.
- 7.7.5 The prohibition and Penalty for a breach of same as outlined above, is in addition to any Penalty/Penalties that may occur as a result of Civil Aviation Authority (CASA) regulations in relation to the use of UAVs in controlled airspace, and over areas containing significant numbers of people.
