#### CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

##### 1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- 1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “MERLIN DARWIN TRIPLE CROWN” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise of race 16, 17 and 18 of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at Hidden Valley Raceway, Darwin, Northern Territory on 15<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

##### 1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

- 1.5.2 **Direction:** Anti- Clockwise
- 1.5.3 **Track Density:** Supercars – 32
- 1.5.4 **Notice Board:** Located in the paddock office (pit exit end of the pit garages).
- 1.5.5 **Stewards Office:** Located adjacent to the paddock office complex – between the pit exit end of the pit garages and the race control tower.
- 1.5.6 **DRD Office:** Located adjacent to the paddock office complex – between the pit exit end of the pit garages and the race control tower.
- 1.5.7 **Control Line:** Located at the Finish Line and across Pit Exit.

## CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

### 2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2022 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **1000hrs (ACST)** on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2022.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2022 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event schedule.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1630hrs (ACST)** on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2022 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.
- 2.1.5 Wildcard Drivers are required to email their licensing in accordance with **Rule A5.1** including a valid Car Club Membership to [motorsportoperations@supercars.com](mailto:motorsportoperations@supercars.com) by **1000hrs (ACST)** Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

## 2.2 SUBJECT OF AN INVESTIGATION NOT TO LEAVE THE EVENT

2.2.1 At this Event, delete **Rule B2.3.1** and replace with the following:

**B2.3.1** Any Driver and/or Authorised Representative of a Competitor who has received written notification from the RD or DRD that such Driver or Competitor of their Car has been involved in any Incident that is the subject of an Investigation by the RD or DRD must not leave the precincts of the Event unless that Driver and/or Authorised Representative has first obtained the permission of the Stewards.

## CHAPTER 3 -OPERATIONS

### 3.1 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.1.3 At the direction of the Paddock Manager, Transporters are permitted to enter the paddock from **1000hrs (ACST)** on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> June 2022.
- 3.1.4 Teams are permitted to commence unloading their transporters at **0830hrs (ACST)** on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2022 or at the direction of the Supercars Paddock Manager.
- 3.1.5 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock at any time.
  - 3.1.5.1 Teams are able wash-down their trucks at the Buslink Bus Depot, 113 Pruen Road, Berrimah NT 0828. The facility will be available on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> June from 9.30am – 2.30pm, a maximum of 2 trucks can be onsite, one in the wash bay and the other in the waiting bay.
  - 3.1.5.2 Teams are asked to make a \$20 donation for the use of the facility. Please note that you will be required to wear high vis and undertake a brief induction.
- 3.1.6 **NO** vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time.

### 3.2 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 Series hard- card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
  - 3.2.1.1 Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> June 2022 to access the Event / Circuit.
  - 3.2.1.2 Site Inductions will be required to be undertaken by any person who is unable to present their accreditation pre-event (prior to and including Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> June).
- 3.2.2 All Series Accreditation, including all Promoter issued accreditation and car passes must use Entrance B (via Marlow's Road).
- 3.2.3 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each Car entry will be allocated four (4) car parking passes to park in CP5, which is at the rear of the Paddock. Only Event issued car passes will be accepted.
- 3.2.4 **Grid Walk Pass collection** – To be collected from the Supercars Operations Truck each morning of the walk.

### 3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

3.3.1 Accreditation Centres are located at **Gate 4** and **Entrance B** (via Marlow's Road).

### 3.4 RACE TRACK WALK

3.4.1 Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> June between **1330hrs and 1530hrs (ACST)**.

### 3.5 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

3.5.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

### 3.6 GOLF BUGGIES

3.6.1 All Golf Buggies must be road registered.

## **CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT/ EVENT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**

### 4.1 COVID-19 RESPONSE

4.1.1 This Event will be in accordance with the Northern Territory State Government COVID-19 Health Orders.

### 5.5 BRIEFINGS

## 5.6 PIT BAY MARKINGS

- 5.6.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.2**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:
- 5.6.1.1 The inside edge of the race tape, marking the right-hand side of the pit box, is not permitted to be greater than 4.4m and parallel from the edge of the Pit Building upright.
  - 5.6.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 2.7m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.

## 5.7 PIT STOPS

- 5.7.1 For races **16, 17 and 18** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
- 5.7.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events**.
  - 5.7.1.2 A Car may only perform a CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.
  - 5.7.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
  - 5.7.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
  - 5.7.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

## 5.8 DRIVER BATH WATER – DRAINAGE

- 5.8.1 At this Event, drainage of Driver baths is prohibited until 1 hour after the conclusion of VCS race 18.

## 5.9 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

- 5.9.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.
- 5.9.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

## 5.10 IN-CAR CAMERA

- 5.10.1 At this Event, Cars are required to have a dummy roof camera fitted, which complies with **Rule C4.1** and **Rule C4.2**.
- 5.10.1.1 There is no requirement for a Car to be fitted with a dummy boot camera or boot camera ballast.

## 5.11 AIR IMPACT TOOLS AND PRESSURE VESSELS

- 5.11.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D11.3.2 a)**:  
D11.3.2 At each Event, a Team must be equipped with a minimum of four (4) air impact tools and an air lance; of which:
- a) maximum of two (2) air impact tools may be used at SuperSprint Events (save for tool failure); and
  - b) a maximum of four (4) air impact tools may be used at all other Events.

## CHAPTER 6 - TECHNICAL

### 6.1 MINIMUM WEIGHT

- 6.1.1 In accordance with the requirements of **Rule C4.1.1**, all Drivers that have not competed in a race of the 2022 Repco Supercars Championship, will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials immediately following practice 2 on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2022, in the Supercars Scales Garage.

### 7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE
