Build notice effective week beginning Monday, 21 October 2024

From Monday, 21 October 2024, temporary infrastructure works will continue in Main Beach and Surfers Paradise to prepare for the Supercars Boost Mobile Gold Coast 500 (GC500) to be held on the 25 – 27 October 2024.

GC500 Race Circuit

On **Monday 21 October** the roads within the GC500 circuit are changed to one-way (anti-clockwise direction). Traffic control will be in place to move all traffic in one direction, no exceptions.

Friday 25 to Sunday 27 October the roads will be closed to implement the GC500. Please see 'Notification of upcoming special event clearways during event days'.

Gold Coast Highway

Monday 21 October – Tuesday 28 November

Gold Coast Highway will be adjusted as follows;

- One lane for northbound traffic;
- One lane for southbound traffic; and
- One emergency lane (eastern lane).

The Esplanade

Monday 21 October – Monday 28 October

To enable construction of garages on The Esplanade, traffic changes will be implemented north of Staghorn Ave; one-way, northbound only.

Surfers Paradise

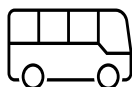
Sunday 20 October – Monday 28 October

Traffic control diversions will be implemented in Budds Beach on Palm Ave, Pine Ave, Norfolk Ave and Britt Ave.

Works include the installation of temporary fencing, portable buildings, scaffold structures and marquees across multiple locations.

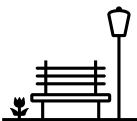
Public access to the Major Event Area will be closed from 25 – 27 October to facilitate the delivery of the GC500.

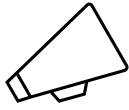

Special event clearway parking restrictions will be in place from Monday 21 October to facilitate the delivery of event infrastructure.

Streets impacted will be:
