CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- 1.1.1 The Event will be known as the “PENRITE OIL SANDOWN 500” (hereinafter referred to as “the Event”), which will also comprise of race 23 of the 2023 Repco Supercars Championship (“the VCS”), and be held at the Sandown International Motor Raceway, Sandown, Victoria on 14th – 17th September 2023.

1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual (“the Rules”), any applicable National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.

- 1.5.2 **Direction:** Anti- Clockwise
- 1.5.3 **Track Density:** Supercars – 36
- 1.5.4 **Stewards Office:** Located in a demountable building behind Race Control.
- 1.5.5 **DRD Office:** Located in a demountable building behind Race Control.

CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION

2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2023 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 All entries (including Wildcard Entries) additional Drivers are required to be nominated using the additional Driver Nomination form no later than Friday 1st September 2023.
- 2.1.2.1 All additional Drivers (including Wildcard Entries) must be nominated in the portal as part of the Event/ Car registration process.
 - 2.1.2.2 All additional Drivers (including Wildcard Entries) are required to upload their insurance, ASN Licence and Car Club to their portal profile no later than Friday 1st September 2023.
- 2.1.3 Administration checking will commence at **0900hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 14th September 2023.

- 2.1.4 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2023 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event Program.
- 2.1.5 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1700hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 14th September 2023 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.

CHAPTER 3 -OPERATIONS

3.1 TRANSPORTER ACCESS TO THE PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 Specific conditions and details of transporter movements into the Supercars paddock will be distributed directly by the Supercars Transport and Logistics Manager. These conditions and timeframes including any predetermined order must be adhered to.
- 3.1.3 All Team Transporters are required to be split and ready to enter the Supercars paddock on Thursday 14th September 2023 at **0800hrs (AEST)**.
- 3.1.4 Teams are permitted to commence unloading their transporters at **0900hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 14th September 2023 or at the direction of the Supercars Paddock Manager.
- 3.1.5 Transporters must not be washed in the paddock at any time.
- 3.1.6 **NO** vehicles are permitted to enter the VCS Paddock at any time.
- 3.1.7 Teams are to supply their own padlocks for garages.

3.2 ACCREDITATION, ACCESS & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 Series hard-card accreditation or Event only ticketing must be presented to gain access to the Event.
- 3.2.1.1 Accreditation will be required on his/her person from Friday 15th September 2023 to access the Event / Circuit.
- 3.2.2 **VCS Teams Car Parking:** Each Car entry will be allocated four (4) VIP car parking passes to park in the VIP / Teams car park. All other Team vehicles will be permitted to park in the general car park. All Team car parking is only accessible via Racecourse Drive.
- 3.2.3 **Team Caterer Transit Pass:** Each Group will be allocated one (1) transit pass to enter the VCS paddock for the sole purpose of delivering supplies outside of Event Operating hours with the vehicle removed immediately after delivery.
- 3.2.4 No Parking is permitted at any time in the VCS Paddock during Event Operating Hours. Teams in breach will be reported to the Stewards.
- 3.2.5 **Grid Walk Pass collection:** To be collected from the Accreditation Centre.

3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.3.1 The Accreditation Centre is located at Gate 2. on Racecourse Drive.

3.3.3 During the Event, all tickets/ passes that require collection by public/ Team guests must be left at the Ticketek Box Office located at Gate 2 (in an envelope with the collector's name). The Box Office will be open approx. 30min ahead of gates opening on Saturday – Sunday.

3.4 RACE TRACK WALK

3.4.1 Teams are only permitted to undertake their Race Track walk on Thursday 14th September 2023 between **1400hrs** and **1600hrs (AEST)**.

3.5 DEMOBILISATION AFTER THE EVENT

3.5.1 Details of the Supercars Paddock demobilisation and Transporter departure after the Event, will be in accordance with the instructions issued to Teams under separate cover by the Supercars Paddock Manager.

3.6 DRIVER BATHS

3.6.1 Teams are to empty Driver baths at the front of Team transporters, no water or bath fluids are permitted to flow towards garages or into another Teams pack up areas.

3.7 GOLF BUGGIES

3.7.1 For this Event, one (1) road registered golf buggy per Team is permitted.

3.7.2 Teams are only permitted to use **Gate 5E** at the rear of the paddock (vehicle gate located near Fuel Bund). If Teams are found to be using any gate other than **Gate 5E**, Sandown Motorsport Park will suspend the use of the buggy for the remainder of the Event.

3.8 ACCESS TO AND USE OF THE PROPERTY

3.8.1 Children in any restricted areas including the paddock must be under the direct supervision of an adult. The Promoter reserves the right to have any offenders removed.

3.8.2 Under no circumstances are stakes to be driven into the bitumen surface.

3.9 SANDOWN RACEWAY VENUE REGULATIONS

3.9.1 Attached is a copy of the Sandown Raceway Venue Regulations. These Regulations must be adhered to, except where in conflict with the Supercars Operations Manual, Supplementary Regulations, Further Supplementary Regulations, Bulletins or any instructions from Supercars for this Event.

4.6.2 The Sandown Road and overpass gate will be closed at approximately **2000hrs (AEST)**. For entry or exit to the venue after this time, please contact 24hour security.

4.7 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

4.7.1 Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defuelling operation;

4.7.2 Motorsport Australia’s National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia’s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at motorsport.org.au.

4.7.3 Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

4.7.4 Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

5.1 FORMAT OF VCS EVENTS

5.1.1 At this Event, the CPS minimum requirements 'No.' will be specified in the *Further Supplementary Regulations*.

5.2 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS -VCS TYRE ALLOCATION, USAGE, ORDER AND PAYMENT

5.3.1 The Event operating hours (**AEST**), for the purpose of **Rule E2.1.1** are as follows:

5.3.1.3 Sunday 17th September 2023 0800 – end of VCS race 23

5.4 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

5.4.1 In accordance with **Rule D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Springvale: <http://www.bom.gov.au/places/vic/springvale/>

5.5 BRIEFINGS

5.5.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1700hrs (AEST)** on Thursday 14th September 2023 in the Vintage Room, located on the first floor of the northern end of the grandstand. Entry is via the green walkway at the rear.

5.5.2 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives & Drivers** will be held at **0830hrs (AEST)** on Saturday 16th September 2023 in the Vintage Room, located on the first floor of the northern end of the grandstand. Entry is via the green walkway at the rear.

5.6 SHADE STRUCTURES

- 5.6.1 Teams are permitted one (1) only 6m by 3m shade structure per Car on the apron at the rear of the Pit Garages. All other shade structures are to be placed next to their transporter.
- 5.6.1.1 All temporary shade structures must be installed no later than **1300hrs (AEST)**, Thursday 14th September 2023 for certification by the City of Dandenong.
- 5.6.2 Teams are required to conform with the requirements for Temporary Structures Weighting Requirements, this will be sent to Teams under separate cover.

5.7 PRACTICE

- 5.7.1 All Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 1, 3 and 4.
- 5.7.2 Only additional Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 2.
- 5.7.3 The Stewards may, in their absolute discretion, order that a Driver who has not completed a suitable number of laps in practice 1, 3 or 4 combined, be required to drive the Car in another Session or Sessions. This decision of the Stewards is not susceptible to appeal.
- 5.7.4 The use of Refuelling Towers is permitted during practice 3.
- 5.7.4.1 Use of Refuelling Towers is not permitted at the end of the Session;
- 5.7.4.2 During practice 3, Cars are required to parallel park in their Pit Bay.
- 5.7.4.3 Attire in accordance with **Rule D23.4.5** is required; and
- 5.7.4.4 At the conclusion of the practice Session, Cars in Pit Lane are required to park in their pit bay.

5.8 WARM-UP

- 5.8.1 The use of Refuelling Towers is permitted during the warm-up Session on Sunday 17th September 2023.
- 5.8.1.1 Use of Refuelling Towers is not permitted at the end of the Session;
- 5.8.1.2 Cars are required to parallel park in their Pit Bay;
- 5.8.1.3 Attire in accordance with **Rule D23.4.5** is required; and
- 5.8.1.4 At the conclusion of the warm-up Session, Cars in Pit Lane are required to park in their pit bay.
- 5.8.1.5 Refuelling Towers are permitted to remain setup and in position for race 23 following warm up.
- 5.8.2 The warm-up Session is time certain.

5.9 PIT STRAIGHT SIGNALLING AREA

- 5.9.1 A restricted area has been established along the signalling wall area due to a lack of Debris Fencing on the signalling guard rail. Please refer to the attached diagram.
- 5.9.2 Should a Team have a Car/pit radio failure, the Team must seek the prior approval of the HoM for a maximum of two (2) Team members to access the area for signalling only. Please refer to the attached diagram.
- 5.9.3 Teams will be permitted to stand along the signalling guard rail in the restricted area at the end of the race in accordance with **Rule D11.5.1**.

5.10 PIT BAY MARKINGS

- 5.10.1 At this Event, and in accordance with **Rule D11.5.8.1**, a Teams Pit Bay is required to be in the following position:
- 5.10.1.1 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the left-hand side of the pit box, is required to be 4.2m and parallel from the edge of the Pit Building upright.

5.10.1.2 The outside edge of the race tape, marking the front line of the pit box, is to be located 1.75m forward, of the centre of the pit building column, where the Teams pit boom is located.

5.10.2 For the purpose of a visual guide to the Driver during ‘double-stacking’ and to ensure the Fastlane is kept clear for transiting Cars, an additional line of race tape must be affixed along the length of the Pit Bay.

5.10.2.1 The outside edge of the race tape marking the “double stack” line is required to be 1.5m from the outside edge of the race tape marking the Pit Bay.

5.11 PIT STOPS DRIVER CHANGE

5.11.1 When stopping to change Drivers and when the Car is in the Pit Lane (40km/h section), the Driver may only loosen the shoulder straps provided they remain substantially in place over the shoulders.

5.12 USE OF EQUIPMENT / TOOLS

5.12.1 At this Event, note the following amendments to **Rule D11.7.8**:

D11.7.8 Air jacks must always be manually operated from the Pit Garage Fastlane side of the Car during any Pit Stop.

5.13 FRONT BRAKE ROTOR RESTRICTIONS – VCS

5.13.1 At this Event, note the following amendment to **Rule D20.1.1** and **D20.1.2.2**:

D20.1.1 Outside Team Testing activities, the Table in **Rule D20.1.2.2** outlines the per Car allocation of front brake rotors and brake pad sets during the 2023 Championship Season Events.

5.14 PIT STOPS

5.14.1 For races **23** the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:

5.14.1.1 Each Car must complete the CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2. Format of VCS Events**.

5.14.1.2 A Car may only perform a CPS after it commences lap 5 on the Race Track.

5.14.1.3 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.

5.14.1.4 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car’s race time.

5.14.1.5 Should the SC be deployed prior to the leader commencing lap 5 on the Race Track, and the SC period continues after the commencement of lap 5, the CPS window will not open. Teams will be updated as to when the window will open via RMC and the Instant Messenger.

5.15 CARS TO CARRY VIDEO RECORDERS

5.15.1 Further to **Rule D21.3.12**, each Team is required to ensure the SD card or USB device fitted to their Car is of sufficient capacity to record the entire race (128Gb or larger capacity).

5.15.1.1 The Judiciary Camera system must use the Scene provided by Supercars at the Event.

5.15.1.2 The Car Number constant and the GPS time offset must be set correctly.

5.16 IN CAR WARNING SYSTEM

- 5.16.1 At this Event, the In-Car Warning System will be operational.
5.16.1.1 Safety Car, Red Flags and Blue Flags are regulatory.

5.17 DESIGN AND SIGNAGE

- 5.17.1 At this Event, note the following new **Rule E1.9.7**:

E1.9.7 In Car Driver & Car ID:

- E1.9.7.1 Each Car must have their Competition number and the Primary Driver's surname always affixed to the dash, legible and visible by the in-Car camera.

5.18 CORPORATE RIDES – CONDITIONS

- 5.18.1 At this Event, delete **Rule E6.10.12.3**.

CHAPTER 6 -TECHNICAL

6.1 MINIMUM WEIGHT

- 6.1.1 In accordance with the requirements of **Rule C4.1.1**:

- 6.1.1.1 All Wildcard Primary Drivers that have not competed in a race of the 2023 Repco Supercars Championship, will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials immediately following practice 1.
6.1.1.2 All additional Drivers (including Wildcard additional Drivers) that have not competed in a race of the 2023 Repco Supercars Championship will be required for weighing by Supercars Officials immediately following practice 2 on Friday 15th September 2023, in the Supercars Scales Garage.

6.2 DROP GEAR RATIOS

- 6.2.1 At this Event and in accordance with **Rule C10.5.1**, all Cars are required to install the "Back Up #1" drop gear of 1.000 from the commencement of the Penrite Oil Sandown 500 event.
6.2.1.1 Drop gear 1.074 as specified in **Rule C10.5.1** for the Sandown International Raceway is also required to be on hand at the Event

CHAPTER 7 -MEDIA / MARKETING/ PROMOTIONAL

7.1 PROMOTIONAL SCHEDULE

- 7.1.1 Teams must adhere to the activities outlined in the promotional schedule and/or any subsequent updates as provided by the Supercars Media and Promotions Department.

7.2 GRID WALKS

- 7.2.1 At this Event, grid walks are permitted.
