#### **CHAPTER 1 - STANDARD REQUIREMENTS**

## 1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1.1 The Event will be known as the "PENRITE OIL SANDOWN 500" (hereinafter referred to as "the Event"), which will also comprise race 28, 29 and 30 of the 2019 International Virgin Australia Supercars Championship ("the VCS"), and be held at the Sandown International Motor Raceway, Sandown, Victoria on 6<sup>th</sup> November – 10<sup>th</sup> November 2019.

#### 1.2 ORGANISATION & STATUS

- 1.2.1 The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Supercars Operations Manual ("the Rules"), and any applicable National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS) which are not in conflict with the Rules, the Supplementary Regulations, any Further Supplementary Regulations or instructions and any Bulletins issued.
- 1.2.2 **Event Status:** Restricted International.

#### **CHAPTER 2 - ADMINISTRATION**

#### 2.1 ENTRIES

- 2.1.1 Competitors must have completed the 2019 Supercars Entry Registration Form.
- 2.1.2 Administration checking will commence at **0830hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2019.
- 2.1.3 Any Competitors that need to change or add any details contained in their 2019 Entry Registration Form must do so at the Supercars Operations Transporter prior to the commencement of the **Competitor's Authorised Representatives Briefing** as detailed in the Event schedule.
- 2.1.4 No change of Drivers will be accepted later than **1730hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2019 unless exceptional circumstances, as determined by the Stewards, warrant a change after that time.
- 2.1.5 Any Entry that has cross entered Drivers, must nominate their final Car pairing prior to **1700hrs (AEDT)** on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2019.







#### 2.2 PRESENTATION OF A CAR

A4.3.3.1

2.2.1 Delete **Rule A4.3.3.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

I being the Authorised Representative of the Car described on the Supercars Entry Registration Form and legally authorised to enter the Car described on this form, hereby declare and undertake to Supercars Australia and the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS) that the Car and all related equipment and components necessary for participation in this Event shall be presented, at all times and in every respect, in a condition suitable for use in this activity, and that I have caused the Car to be inspected according to a maintenance schedule which I have developed and that it is free from mechanical defects, be they of preparation or structural integrity, that may render the Car unsafe for the proposed activity.

Further, I acknowledge and agree that where any aspect of the Car or related equipment and components is found:

- to be in breach of the Rules and/or the Regulations of the Event, or;
- in the opinion of the Sporting & Technical Director Head of Motorsport, to be subject to a serious mechanical defect, it will render me in breach of the Rules, and that I may be subject to penalties in accordance with the Rules.

#### 2.3 HEARINGS

2.3.1 Delete **Rule B3.11.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

<u>B3.11.1</u> After the Hearing has concluded, the Stewards notify the persons and parties concerned of their decision on the matter consistent with the information available at the Hearing, and subject to Rule <u>B8.2 B7.2</u> impose such Penalties and make such orders and give such directions as they may think fit.

#### **CHAPTER 3 - OPERATIONS**

#### 3.1 ACCESS TO PADDOCK

- 3.1.1 The set-up of the Supercars paddock will be at the discretion of Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.2 All Team Transporters are required to be split and ready to enter the Supercars paddock on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2019 at **1400hrs (AEDT).**
- 3.1.3 Teams are permitted to commence unloading their transporters on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2019 once all Supercars transporters are in their final park up position, unless otherwise approved by the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate.
- 3.1.4 Teams are to supply their own padlocks for garages.
- 3.1.5 No vehicles are permitted in the paddock after **0800hrs (AEDT)** on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2019, save for Supplementary Regulation 3.2.4.

### 3.2 ACCREDITATION CARDS (PASSES) & TEAM PARKING

- 3.2.1 The Series Accreditation Cards will be recognised by the Organisers.
- 3.2.2 Accreditation will be required from Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2019.
- 3.2.3 Each entry will be allocated 4 VIP car parking passes to park in the VIP/Teams car park located on Racecourse Drive. All other Team vehicles will be permitted to park in the general car park.







- 3.2.4 Each Team caterer will be allocated one (1) transit car pass and will be permitted to enter the paddock for the sole purpose of delivering supplies.
  - 3.2.4.1 All deliveries must be completed outside of the Event Operating hours as listed in Supplementary Regulation 5.4 Cars with this pass must park in the general car park.

#### 3.3 ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING HOURS

- 3.3.1 The Accreditation centre is located at Gate 2 on Racecourse Drive.
- 3.3.2 The accreditation centre will be open at the following times (AEDT):

3.5.1 Teams are permitted to conduct a Race Track walk on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2019 between **1200hrs and 1700hrs (AEDT).** 

#### 3.6 TRANSPORTER DEPARTURE AFTER THE EVENT

3.6.1 Unless otherwise advised by the Supercars Paddock Manager or their delegate, no Team transporter will be permitted to move from its allocated position or leave the Supercars paddock prior to two (2) hours after the completion of race 30 on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2019.

## **CHAPTER 4 -SPECIFIC CIRCUIT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**

#### 4.1 MEDICAL SERVICES

4.1.1 The Medical Centre is located at pit entry and will be operational during the following times (all times are AEDT):

#### 4.5 24HR VENUE SECURITY

4.5.1 The 24-hour security contact for the Event can be contacted on: 0402 079 198.

4.5.2 A security officer will be located in the paddock area each night from **1700hrs** to **0700hrs** AEDT, commencing on the evening of Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November and concluding on the morning of Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November. Teams wishing to work during the night are welcome to do so; however, the Sandown Road and over pass gate will be closed at approximately **2000hrs AEDT**. For entry or exit to the venue after this time, please contact the 24hour security.

#### 4.6 GOLF BUGGIES

- 4.6.1 Golf buggies must be road registered.
- 4.6.2 Teams are only permitted to use Gate 5E at the rear of the paddock (vehicle gate located near Fuel Bund). If Teams are found to be using any gate other than Gate 5E, the owner of Sandown Motorsport Park will require the use of your buggy to be suspended for the remainder of the Event.

#### 4.7 DELIVERIES AND ACCESS BY NON-ENDORSED EVENT SUPPLIERS

4.7.1 It is the Team's responsibility to ensure any service providers/contractors they engage who are not an endorsed supplier, have the correct accreditation to access the venue and any applicable site safety induction is completed.

#### 4.8 ACCESS TO AND USE OF THE PROPERTY

- 4.8.1 Children in any restricted areas including the paddock must be under the direct supervision of an adult. The Promoter reserves the right to have any offenders removed.
- 4.8.2 Under no circumstances are stakes to be driven into the bitumen surface.

#### 4.9 SANDOWN RACEWAY VENUE REGULATIONS

4.9.1 Attached is a copy of the Sandown Raceway Venue Regulations. These Regulations must be adhered to, except where in conflict with the Supercars Operations Manual, Supplementary Regulations, Further Supplementary Regulations, Bulletins or any instructions from Supercars for this Event.

#### 4.10 HEALTH AND SAFETY

4.10.1 In line with the Victorian Health and Safety Act, the Supercars Paddock will be a smokefree zone for the duration of the Event.







## 4.11 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES (UAV) PROHIBITION

- 4.11.1 Be advised that the use (operation) of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), drones, or other similar devices, by any Competitor, Team, Team member or person/s associated with a Team or Competitor is prohibited.
- 4.11.2 This prohibition extends for the period of the Event defined as the Event period over the Event area defined as the Event area.
- 4.11.3 It also includes the prohibition of the use (operation) of any unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), drone or similar device from outside the declared area of the Event over the declared area during the Event period.
- 4.11.4 A breach of this prohibition will result in disqualification from the Event for any offending Competitor and or Team and Driver/s. All credentials or admission tickets issued to any offending Competitor or Team, and associated personnel will also be withdrawn.
- 4.11.5 The prohibition and Penalty for a breach of same as outlined above, is in addition to any Penalty/Penalties that may occur as a result of breaching Civil Aviation Authority (CASA) regulations in relation to the use of UAVs in controlled airspace, and over areas containing significant numbers of people.

### **CHAPTER 5 - SPORTING**

#### 5.1 TYRE FITTING, ALLOCATION AND USAGE

- 5.1.1 Control tyre fitting will commence from **0900hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2019 in the Dunlop garages located in the Supercars Paddock.
- 5.1.2 The Dunlop tyre fitting hours of operation are as follows:

5.1.2.1 Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November 0800 – 1800 5.1.2.2 Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> November 0730 – 1830

5.1.2.3 Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November 0730 – end of VCS race 30

## 5.2 MARKINGS ON CARS

5.2.1 Delete **Rule E1.6.2.3** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**E1.6.2.3** The surnames of each Driver must be:

a) Height: Sprint Events & DS2 Rounds: 400 80mm

Endurance Events: 50 35mm

b) Font: Sprint Events & DS2 Rounds: Helvetica Bold Condensed

Endurance Events: Helvetica Bold Condensed

Position: Lower edge of each rear door window.

5.2.2 Delete **reference 2, 4 and 8**. in **Schedule E1 Markings on Cars** in its entirety and replace with the below:

#### 5.3 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PITS AND PADDOCK

5.3.1 Update Rule **E3.2.7** with the below additional Rule:

<u>All gas cylinders must be secured and have the main valve in the fully off position during all movements at an Event.</u>

#### 5.4 EVENT OPERATING HOURS

5.4.1 The Event operating hours (AEDT) for the purpose of Rule E2 are as follows:

5.4.1.1 Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November 0805 – 1750

5.4.1.2 Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> November 0800 – after VCS race 29 5.4.1.3 Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November 0835 – after VCS race 30

5.4.2 All Competitors are reminded that the permit issued by the City of Greater Dandenong for the Event stipulates that no race engines may be in use outside of the following hours (all times are AEDT):

5.4.2.1	Friday 8 <sup>th</sup> November	0800 - 1800
5.4.2.2	Saturday 9 <sup>th</sup> November	0800 - 1800
5.4.2.3	Sunday 10th November	0900 – 1800

#### 5.5 BRIEFINGS

- 5.5.1 A briefing for all **Competitor's Authorised Representatives** will be held at **1730hrs (AEDT)** on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2019 in the Vintage Room, located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the northern end of the grandstand. Entry is via the green walkway at the rear.
- 5.5.2 A briefing for all **Competitors and Drivers** will be held at **1830hrs (AEDT)** on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2019 in the Vintage Room, located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the northern end of the grandstand. Entry is via the green walkway at the rear.

#### 5.6 SHADE STRUCTURES

- 5.6.1 Teams are permitted one (1) only 6m by 3m shade structure per Car on the apron at the rear of the Pit Garages. All other shade structures are to be placed next to their transporter.
- 5.6.2 Teams are required to conform with the requirements for Temporary Structures Weighting Requirements, outlined in the Team Induction Brief sent to all Teams under separate cover.

#### 5.7 DRIVER CONDITIONS POLICY

5.7.1 In accordance with Rule **D3.4.4**, the nearest Town or City to the Circuit, as listed by the Bureau of Meteorology is Springvale. http://www.bom.gov.au./places/vic/springvale

#### 5.8 PRACTICE

- 5.8.1 All Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 2 and 4.
- 5.8.2 Only additional Drivers are permitted to drive in practice 1 and 3.

#### 5.9 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – START PROCEDURE

5.9.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D8.3.2.4** in its entirety and replace with the following:

**D8.3.2.4** Team members may then approach the Car.

<u>D8.3.2.4.1</u> Team trolleys are required to be positioned directly behind the rear of the Car and perpendicular to the track direction.

<u>D8.3.2.4.2</u> Teams are not permitted to use a fan of any type, with the exception of Driver cooling.





#### 5.10 START PROCEDURE

5.10.1 All Cars exiting Pit Lane prior to the start of a race must have their Pit Lane speed limiter activated until the Car has passed the starter's tower.

#### 5.11 SAFETY CAR PROCEDURE

5.11.1 For this Event, delete **Rule D10.2.13** in its entirety and replace with the following:

<u>D10.2.13</u> Prior to the lead Car crossing the Control Line at the end of a SC deployment, or on the restart lap, any Car that is two (2) or more laps behind the lead Car must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is less than two (2) laps behind the lead Car.

Should a SC deployment end eight (8) laps or less from the last lap of a race, or ten (10) minutes prior to the time certain finish time of a race as published in the Supplementary Regulations, any Car that is one (1) or more laps behind the leader must reposition itself by driving through the Pit Lane so that it is not in front of any Car that is on the lead lap.

#### 5.12 AIR IMPACT TOOLS AND PRESSURE VESSELS

5.12.1 At this Event, delete **Rule D11.3.2** in its entirety and replace with the following:

<u>D11.3.2</u> A Team must be equipped with a minimum of four (4) air impact tools and an air lance during any race.

<u>Pressure Sensors are not permitted to be affixed to any air line connected to an air impact tool or air lance.</u>

#### 5.13 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PIT LANE

5.13.1 Delete **Rule D11.5.2.1** in its entirety and replace with the following:

<u>D11.5.2.1</u> Only Officials, Team members in accordance with Rule <u>D8.1.8</u> <u>D8.1.6</u> and media personnel specifically authorised by the RD, are permitted at the Pit signalling wall from the time that the Cars move off on the formation lap.

## 5.14 SPECIFIC PRESCRIPTIONS – PIT LANE (PROHIBITED DEVICES)

5.14.1 For this Event, update **Rule D11.5.6** Prohibited Devices with the following Rule:

**D11.5.6** Prohibited Devices

<u>With prior approval from the HoM, connecting a computer or electronic device to a Car during a Pit Stop during a Race is permitted. D11.2.9.2 will not apply for a crew member passing a data cable across the Prescribed Line for the purpose of connecting a computer or electronic device to the Car.</u>

#### 5.15 USE OF EQUIPMENT / TOOLS

5.15.1 At this Event, update **Rule D11.7** with the following:

<u>D11.7.11</u> <u>Teams are not permitted to use a data logger affixed on any pitlane equipment.</u>

#### 5.16 PIT STOPS – DRIVER CHANGE

5.16.1 When stopping to change Drivers and when the Car is in the Pit Lane (40km/h section), the Driver may only loosen the shoulder straps provided they remain substantially in place over the shoulders.



# SUPERCAR:

## 5.17 PERSONNEL

5.17.1 For this Event, update **Rule D11.2.4** as per below:

**D11.2.4** Refueler / Vent Attendant

D11.2.4.1 Whose sole task is to hold, operate and control the Refuelling/vent hose in accordance with Rule D25.6.2.

<u>Permitted to assist with servicing of the Car during Pit Stops</u> where no refuelling is conducted.

5.17.2 For this Event update **Rule D11.2.6** as per below:

**D11.2.6** Fire Attendant

**D11.2.6.1** Whose sole task is to operate the fire extinguisher in accordance with **Rule D25.6.2**.

<u>Permitted to assist with servicing of the Car during Pit Stops</u> where no refuelling is conducted.

#### 5.18 PIT STRAIGHT SIGNALLING AREA

- 5.18.1 A restricted area has been established along the signalling wall area due to a lack of Debris Fencing on the signalling guard rail. Please refer to the attached diagram.
- 5.18.2 Should a Team have a Car/pit radio failure, the Team must seek the prior approval of the HoM for a maximum of two (2) Team members to access the area for signalling only. Please refer to the attached diagram.
- 5.18.3 Teams will be permitted to stand along the signalling guard rail in the restricted area at the end of the race in accordance with **Rule D11.5.1**.

#### 5.19 PIT STOPS

- 5.19.1 For race 30, the following additional CPS requirements must be complied with:
  - 5.19.1.1 Each Car must complete the one (1) CPS requirements as per **Schedule A2.** Format of VCS Events.
  - 5.19.1.2 During the CPS, the Control Tyres removed from the Car cannot be refitted to the Car during that CPS.
  - 5.19.1.3 The Penalty for failure to complete a CPS will be a Time Penalty added to that Car's race time.
- 5.19.2 For this Event, delete Rule **D11.8.8** in its entirety and replace with the following:
  - During any Pit Stop, from the time the Car leaves the ground until the time the Car has returned to the ground, the brake lock mechanism must be engaged so as the rear wheels do not rotate without the prior approval of the HoM.
    - <u>D11.8.8.1</u> Where the HoM grants such approval, the <u>rear</u> wheels must stop rotating prior to the Car being lowered to the ground. For the sake of clarity, the <u>rear</u> wheels must not be rotating while the Car is being lowered to the ground.
    - <u>During any Pit Stop</u>, a slight movement of the rear wheels will not, at the sole discretion of the HoM, constitute the rear wheels rotating.

#### 5.20 QUALIFYING RACES

- 5.20.1 Only additional Drivers are permitted to drive in race 28.
- 5.20.2 Only Primary Drivers are permitted to drive in race 29.







#### 5.21 PARC FERMÉ

5.21.1 At this Event, update Rule **D13.5.1** as follows:

Unless otherwise authorised by the HoM, Teams are only permitted to D13.5.1 undertake the following while any Car is in Parc Fermé:

Check Control Tyres pressures; D13.5.1.1

D13.5.1.2 Loosen the wheels:

D13.5.1.3 Rotate the wheels:

D13.5.1.4 Install cool suit loop lines and remove dry ice;

D13.5.1.5 Position cooling fans in the radiator and/or brake duct in takes in the front bumper bar;

D13.5.1.6 Connect auxiliary power pack;

One crew member is permitted to download the Data Logger; D13.5.1.7

Within 20 minutes of the Session being complete, data from the D13.5.1.8 fastest lap and the last outing from the Session must be uploaded to a network location specified by the MOM.

- a. For any VCS race, all data from the Session must be supplied;
- b. For the final VCS race of the Event, data must be supplied to the Supercars Motorsport Department on the provided USB storage device within 20 minutes of the session being complete.

#### 5.22 REFUELLING

5.22.1 The use of refuelling towers is permitted during warm-up on Sunday. 5.22.1.1 Cars are required to parallel park in their Pit Bay during refuelling.

#### 5.23 POINT SCORE

5.23.1 Delete **Rule D14.1.5** in its entirety and replace with the following:

Each Driver will be awarded points based on the Final Classification of each race in the VCS and the DS2, subject to any Penalties imposed.

#### 5.24 **CONTROL TYRES**

5.24.1 Delete **Rule D17.1.15** in its entirety and replace with the following:

It is not permitted for a Team to seek, order or accept the direct supply of any D17.1.15 H, S or SS Control Tyres from Dunlop.

#### 5.25 FRONT BRAKE ROTORS

- 5.25.1 Only marked sets of front discs are permitted at this Event.
- 5.25.2 All marked front discs count towards **Rule D19.1**.

#### 5.26 CARS TO CARRY VIDEO RECORDERS

- 5.26.1 Further to Rule D20.3.13, SD cards must be cleared and reformatted prior to the 30-minute signal for race 30 on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2019, however, must not be cleared prior to 30 minutes after the completion of Sunday's warm up, without the prior written permission of the HOM.
- 5.26.2 Each Team is required to ensure the entire race is recorded on the provided SD Card. The camera settings should be set to record at a screen resolution of 720 and a frame rate of 60 FPS.





## 5.27 FUEL RIGS

5.27.1 Fuel rigs are not permitted to be stored in pit lane, spare garages or breezeways.
