

EVENT ACCESSIBILITY INFORMATION

Accessibility

There are two accessible parking options available at Mt Panorama.

Accessible Car Park 1 - With the proper vehicle accreditation, accessible parking is available off Ray Bant Drive, immediately behind Accessible Viewing Platform 1, located on the outside of the circuit at Murray's Corner. Access is via Gate 1 from Panorama Drive roundabout, provided the vehicle contains correct accreditation and all passengers in the vehicle are appropriately accredited with event tickets prior to entering the Gate.

Accessible Car Park 2 - Accessible Parking is available in the main car park adjacent to Gate 4. Enter the car park off Panorama Drive.

Drop off and Pick Up Areas

An accessible drop off area is located near the main entrance, Gate 4. in the General car park off Panorama Drive.

Accessible Viewing Platforms

There are two dedicated viewing platforms available at this year's event.

Viewing Platform 1 - Located on the outside of the circuit, just prior to Murrays Corner, between the Rydges Hotel and National Motor Museum.

Viewing Platform 2 - Located in Merchandise Alley (Harris Park) at Murrays Corner, next to the pedestrian bridge to the National Motor Museum.

Access to both platforms require an Accessible Platform ticket for those patrons who require and their one (1) companion.

Please note that there is a strict one carer/companion policy.

If you require access to Accessible Seating, please complete the Accessible Seating Form via Ticketek.

Lift Access to Pit Building

For any corporate clients who have tickets in the Pit Building, there is a passenger lift located on the ground floor between tower 2 and 3.

Gates

For access to Viewing Platform 1 the best entry gatse are Gate 1 and Gate 21.

For access to Viewing Platform 2 the best entry gate is Gate 4.

Concession Tickets

Patrons holding a valid concession card are eligible to purchase tickets to the accessible platform at the concession price.

Companion Card Holders

Companion Card holders are entitled to receive a complimentary companion ticket including access to the accessible platform when accompanying a paying customer.

Accessible Amenities

There are a number of wheelchair friendly toilets in the precinct. Locations are:

- Pit Building
- · Near Viewing Platform 1 outside the circuit
- In Merchandise Allev near Viewing Platform 2
- Mc Phillamy Park (need a MLAK key to access)

People living with disability face a vast range of challenges in their daily lives such as restricted access to social and cultural events. Changing places facilities, such as Marveloos, enable people with disabilities, their carers and families to visit places or attend events they might not otherwise attend because of inadequate toilet facilities.

What is a Marveloo?

A Marveloo is a purpose built mobile Changing Places facility which features:

- · Overhead ceiling hoist
- · Height adjustable adult change table
- · Fully accessible toilet
- Curtains for extra privacy
- · Access ramp and automatic door
- Heating and cooling

Organisation (Vivability Limited, we provide individualised flexible, inclusive and engaging programs to individuals with disabilities) purchased Marveloo, one of only ten available in Australia for hire. Access to the Marveloo is via MLAK key, which are readily available.

Track Crossings

Track crossings are no longer required as Bathurst Regional Council has installed a lift on the Repco Bridge allowing access to the inside of the track.

Accessible Access Around the Precinct

Accessible shuttle bus services will be available on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday of the event between 8.30am and 6.30nm

Patrons must call Bathurst Bus Lines on 0408 482 951 to arrange pickup. Any transfers that are within the bottom of the venue will not be charged.

The shuttle will pick patrons up from Viewing Platform 1 on the outside of Murray's Corner and drop Off to the desired location. Once ready to return patrons will need to contact the shuttle driver again to be picked up and returned to the desired platform.
